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6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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- 8 **Section 1.** W.S. 11-16-133(a) and 11-16-134(c)(intro)
- 9 are amended to read:

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- 11 11-16-133. Tax levied on property in district;
- 12 maximum amount; soil and water conservation fund; other
- 13 appropriation authorized.

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(a) Subject to W.S. 11-16-134, the county 1 2 commissioners may annually levy a tax to carry out this 3 act. The tax shall be levied upon all property in the 4 district and shall not exceed one (1) mill on each one dollar (\$1.00) of assessed valuation for a general 5 conservation tax and one (1) mill on each one dollar 6 (\$1.00) of assessed valuation for a water specific purpose 7 8 tax. The tax is not part of the general county or city mill levies. The tax shall be levied and collected as 9 10 other county taxes and the county treasurer shall remit the 11 taxes collected to the district to a separate fund to be 12 known as the general conservation district fund or the 13 water specific purpose fund, which funds shall be used only 14 to carry out the purposes of this act.

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16 **11-16-134**. Imposition of tax; vote of electors 17 required.

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(c) Subject to the limitation of subsection (b) of this section, the proposition to impose a tax under this act shall be submitted on an election date authorized under W.S. 22-21-103, or by mail ballot pursuant to W.S. 22-29-115 and 22-29-116. A notice of election shall be

given by the county clerk in at least one (1) newspaper of 1 2 general circulation published in the county wherein the 3 election is to be held and shall specify the object of the 4 election for a general conservation tax, a water specific 5 purpose tax or both taxes separately. The notice shall be published at least once each week for a thirty (30) day 6 period preceding the election. At the election the ballots 7 8 for the general conservation tax shall contain the words "for the conservation district tax" and "against the 9 10 conservation district tax" and the ballots for the water 11 specific purpose tax shall contain the words "for the 12 conservation, development, utilization, flood prevention 13 and disposal of water within the district" and "against the 14 conservation, development, utilization, flood prevention and disposal of water within the district". Upon the 15 16 initial submission of either the general conservation 17 district tax or the water specific purpose tax, or any 18 renewal thereof, after July 1, 1995, the conservation 19 district board of supervisors shall choose one (1) of the 20 following options and the words of the chosen option shall 21 be clearly printed in the appropriate area on the election 22 ballot:
