## A BILL

for

AN ACT relating to property; prohibiting the state and its 1 political subdivisions from adopting policies originating 2 3 in the United Nations Agenda 21 that restrict private property rights without due process; prohibiting the state 4 5 and its political subdivisions from entering into certain 6 agreements and expending and receiving monies to implement 7 policies related to the United Nations Agenda 21; providing definitions; and providing for an effective date. 8

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10 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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12 **Section 1.** W.S. 9-14-201 is created to read:

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14 ARTICLE 2

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5 (a) Neither the state of Wyoming nor any political subdivision thereof shall adopt or implement policies that 6 intentionally or recklessly infringe on or restrict private 7 8 property rights without due process, as may be required by policy recommendations pursuant to Agenda 21 or any other 9 international law or ancillary plan of action 10 11 contravenes the United States constitution or the 12 constitution of Wyoming.

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14 (b) Neither the state of Wyoming nor any political
15 subdivision thereof shall enter into any agreement with,
16 expend any monies for, receive monies from, contract
17 services from, or give financial aid to nongovernmental and
18 intergovernmental organizations accredited or enlisted by
19 the United Nations to assist in the implementation of its
20 policies related to Agenda 21.

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22 (c) As used in this section:

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1 (i) "Agenda 21" means the plan of action adopted by the United Nations in 1992 at its Conference on 2 3 Environment and Development; 4 5 (ii) "Political subdivision" means any county, municipality, unincorporated city or town, special district 6 7 and any other local government entity. 8 Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2015. 9
