A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to peace officers; expanding the arrest
2 authority of peace officers for probation or parole
3 violations as specified; and providing for an effective
4 date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 7-13-411(b) is amended to read:

10 **7-13-411. Apprehension of violators.**

12 (b) A peace officer may arrest without warrant an
13 alleged probation or parole violator after receiving a
14 written statement from a probation and parole agent setting
15 forth that the probationer or parolee has, in the judgment

1 of the probation and parole agent, violated the conditions
2 of his probation or parole. A peace officer may also arrest
3 without warrant an alleged probation or parole violator at
4 any time the peace officer has probable cause to believe
5 the probationer or parolee has violated the conditions of
6 his probation or parole. A person arrested under this
7 subsection may be detained for a reasonable period of time
8 until a legal warrant is obtained or pending further
9 proceedings under W.S. 7-13-408.

11 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2015.
