department shall issue 1 (d) The without 2 lifetime bird, small game and fish licenses to any resident 3 or honorably discharged veteran who is over sixty-five (65) 4 years and who has continuously resided in Wyoming for at 5 the thirty (30) years, immediately preceding least application for the license, or to any disabled veteran who 6 is one hundred percent (100%) disabled as determined by the 7 8 United States department of veteran affairs. The license is 9 valid so long as the licensee remains a Wyoming resident. 10 11 (e) The department shall issue: 12 (i) For a fee of two dollars (\$2.00) a resident 13 14 deer, antelope or wild turkey license and for a fee of five 15 dollars (\$5.00) an elk license to any resident who is at 16 least seventy-five (75) years of age prior to the issuance of the license and who has continuously resided in Wyoming 17 18 for at least the fifty (50) years; immediately preceding 19 application for the license; 20
