Bar and grill liquor licenses.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to liquor licenses; increasing the number  
2 of bar and grill licenses available; and providing for an  
3 effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 12-4-413(b)(i) through (iv) and  
8 (c)(i) is amended to read:

9

10 **12-4-413. Bar and grill liquor license; authorized;**  
11 **requirements.**

12

13 (b) The number of bar and grill liquor licenses for  
14 cities and towns shall be based on the following population  
15 formula:

16

1 (i) Not more than ~~two (2)~~ three (3) licenses in  
2 incorporated cities or towns of seven thousand five hundred  
3 (7,500) or less; and

4

5 (ii) Not more than ~~three (3)~~ five (5) licenses  
6 for population in incorporated cities between seven  
7 thousand five hundred one (7,501) and fifteen thousand  
8 (15,000); and

9

10 (iii) Not more than ~~four (4)~~ six (6) licenses  
11 for population in incorporated cities between fifteen  
12 thousand one (15,001) and twenty-seven thousand five  
13 hundred (27,500); and

14

15 (iv) Not more than one (1) additional license  
16 for each additional ~~seven thousand five hundred (7,500)~~  
17 five thousand (5,000) population in incorporated cities  
18 over twenty-seven thousand five hundred (27,500).

20 (c) Bar and grill liquor licenses may be granted by  
21 the county commissioners as the appropriate licensing  
22 authority in a county outside of incorporated cities and  
23 towns as follows:

1

2 (i) One (1) license for each ~~seven thousand five~~  
3 ~~hundred (7,500)~~ five thousand (5,000) population residing  
4 outside incorporated cities and towns.

6 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2015.
