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11	(c) All health benefit plans covering small employers
12	shall comply with the following provisions:
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14	(vi) If a small employer carrier offers coverage
15	to a small employer, it shall offer coverage to all of the

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small employer's eligible employees and may offer coverage 1 2 to their dependents. A small employer carrier shall not 3 offer coverage to only certain persons in a group or to only part of a group, except in the case of late enrollees 4 5 as provided in paragraph (iii) of this subsection. Except as permitted under paragraphs (i) and (iii) of this 6 subsection, a small employer carrier shall not modify a 7 8 health benefit plan with respect to a small employer or any 9 eligible employee or dependent, through riders, 10 endorsements or otherwise, to restrict or exclude coverage 11 or benefits for specified diseases, medical conditions or 12 services otherwise covered by the plan; 13 14 Section 2.
