State protection of data privacy.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to administration of government; specifying
2 powers and duties of the department of enterprise
3 technology services over data privacy; specifying that
4 department data privacy policies and standards shall be the
5 minimum privacy requirements adhered to by state agencies;
6 and providing for an effective date.

8 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

10 **Section 1.** W.S. 9-2-2906(d) (i) (A) and (iii) is
11 amended to read:

12

13 **9-2-2906. Office of the state chief information**
14 **officer and director; authority; duties of department.**

15

1 (d) The department shall carry out the following
2 oversight and approval functions:

3
4 (i) Review agency expenditure requests for
5 information technology or telecommunications personnel,
6 hardware or software or contractual services for
7 information technology if the expenditure exceeds the
8 maximum amount established by department policy for small
9 purchases. No funds for purchase in excess of the maximum
10 amount shall be expended until the state chief information
11 officer has approved the expenditure. Upon request for
12 expenditure, the state chief information officer shall
13 review the request and shall:

14
15 (A) Disapprove a request which fails to
16 meet existing department standards, security, privacy and
17 procurement policies; and

19 (iii) Establish and enforce data security and
20 privacy policies and standards for the state data
21 infrastructure. These provisions shall be the minimum
22 security and privacy requirements adhered to by all
23 agencies. Agencies may choose to set additional security

1 and privacy requirements to exceed but not in lieu of or
2 that in any way interfere with the standards set by the
3 state chief information officer;

5 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2015.
