(e) In administering this section and in addition to 1 2 other requirements imposed under this chapter and the 3 Wyoming Medical Assistance and Services Act and federal 4 rule and regulation, the department shall by rule and regulation: 5 6 7 (iv) Establish only one (1) earned income 8 disregard for determining assistance payable under W.S. 9 42-2-104 at two hundred dollars (\$200.00) six hundred 10 dollars (\$600.00) per month for any one (1) recipient. For 11 married couples the earned income disregard shall be four hundred dollars (\$400.00) per month.
