14 recently completed calendar year of less than three hundred
15 thousand dollars (\$300,000.00) per mill shall first receive an
16 amount equal to three (3) times the difference between three
17 hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000.00) and the actual value of
18 one (1) mill within the county. From the remainder, each county
19 shall receive amounts in accordance with a county supplemental
20 funding formula as provided in this paragraph. The county
21 supplemental funding formula shall be calculated by the office
22 of state lands and investments as follows:
23
24 (A) Calculate the per capita sales and use tax
25 revenues available to each county using the sales and use tax
26 distributions to each county during the odd-numbered fiscal year
27 from the most recently completed biennium, excluding
28 distributions to each municipality within that county, under
29 W.S. 39-15-111 and 39-16-111;

31 (B) Calculate the inverse by dividing one (1) by
32 the per capita sales and use tax determined under subparagraph
33 (A) of this paragraph for each county;
34
35 (C) Calculate the normalized per capita sales
36 and use tax number for each county by dividing the number
37 determined under subparagraph (B) of this paragraph for the
38 county by the total of all inverse per capita sales and use tax
39 numbers calculated under subparagraph (B) of this paragraph;

41 (D) Multiply the normalized per capita sales and
42 use tax number determined under subparagraph (C) of this
43 paragraph for each county by twenty-four percent (24%);

1 (E) Calculate the per capita assessed value for
2 each county by dividing the total assessed valuation within the
3 county for the prior tax year corresponding to the most recently
4 completed calendar year by the population of the county;

6 (F) Calculate the inverse by dividing one (1) by
7 the per capita assessed value determined under subparagraph (E)
8 of this paragraph for each county;

9
10 (G) Calculate the normalized per capita assessed
11 value number for each county by dividing the number determined
12 under subparagraph (F) of this paragraph for the county by the
13 total of all inverse per capita assessed value numbers
14 calculated under subparagraph (F) of this paragraph;

15
16 (H) Multiply the normalized per capita assessed
17 value number determined under subparagraph (G) of this paragraph
18 for each county by seventy-six percent (76%);

19
20 (J) Calculate a cost of government index for
21 each county, which shall be determined by multiplying six
22 hundred twenty-eight (628) by the population of the county, and
23 then adding nine million nine hundred thousand (9,900,000) to
24 the result;

25
26 (K) Calculate the normalized cost of government
27 index number for each county by dividing the number determined
28 under subparagraph (J) of this paragraph for the county by the
29 total of all cost of government index numbers calculated under
30 subparagraph (J) of this paragraph;

31
32 (M) Multiply the sum of subparagraphs (D) and
33 (H) of this paragraph by the normalized cost of government index
34 number determined in subparagraph (K) of this paragraph for each
35 county;

36
37 (N) Calculate the normalized index for each
38 county by dividing the number determined under subparagraph (M)
39 of this paragraph for the county by the total of all numbers
40 calculated under subparagraph (M) of this paragraph;

41
42 (O) Determine the amount to distribute to each
43 county by multiplying the normalized index number determined
44 under subparagraph (N) of this paragraph by the amount remaining
45 available for distribution under this paragraph."
