9 "(i) From these distributions each county with an assessed  
10 value for the prior tax year corresponding to the most recently  
11 completed calendar year of less than three hundred thousand  
12 dollars (\$300,000.00) per mill shall first receive an amount  
13 equal to three (3) times the difference between three hundred  
14 thousand dollars (\$300,000.00) and the actual value of one (1)  
15 mill within the county. From the remainder, each county shall  
16 receive amounts in accordance with a county supplemental funding  
17 formula as provided in this paragraph. The county supplemental  
18 funding formula shall be calculated by the office of state lands  
19 and investments as follows:  
20

21 (A) Calculate the per capita sales and use tax  
22 revenues available to each county using the sales and use tax  
23 distributions to each county during the odd-numbered fiscal year  
24 from the most recently completed biennium, excluding  
25 distributions to each municipality within that county, under  
26 W.S. 39-15-111 and 39-16-111;  
27

28 (B) Calculate the inverse by dividing one (1) by  
29 the per capita sales and use tax determined under subparagraph  
30 (A) of this paragraph for each county;  
31

32 (C) Calculate the normalized per capita sales  
33 and use tax number for each county by dividing the number  
34 determined under subparagraph (B) of this paragraph for the  
35 county by the total of all inverse per capita sales and use tax  
36 numbers calculated under subparagraph (B) of this paragraph;  
37

38 (D) Multiply the normalized per capita sales and  
39 use tax number determined under subparagraph (C) of this  
40 paragraph for each county by twenty-four percent (24%);  
41

42 (E) Calculate the per capita assessed value for  
43 each county by dividing the total assessed valuation within the

1 county for the prior tax year corresponding to the most recently  
2 completed calendar year by the population of the county;

3  
4 (F) Calculate the inverse by dividing one (1) by  
5 the per capita assessed value determined under subparagraph (E)  
6 of this paragraph for each county;

7  
8 (G) Calculate the normalized per capita assessed  
9 value number for each county by dividing the number determined  
10 under subparagraph (F) of this paragraph for the county by the  
11 total of all inverse per capita assessed value numbers  
12 calculated under subparagraph (F) of this paragraph;

13  
14 (H) Multiply the normalized per capita assessed  
15 value number determined under subparagraph (G) of this paragraph  
16 for each county by seventy-six percent (76%);

17  
18 (J) Calculate a cost of government index for  
19 each county, which shall be determined by multiplying six  
20 hundred twenty-eight (628) by the population of the county, and  
21 then adding nine million nine hundred thousand (9,900,000) to  
22 the result;

23  
24 (K) Calculate the normalized cost of government  
25 index number for each county by dividing the number determined  
26 under subparagraph (J) of this paragraph for the county by the  
27 total of all cost of government index numbers calculated under  
28 subparagraph (J) of this paragraph;

29  
30 (M) Multiply the sum of subparagraphs (D) and  
31 (H) of this paragraph by the normalized cost of government index  
32 number determined in subparagraph (K) of this paragraph for each  
33 county;

34  
35 (N) Calculate the normalized index for each  
36 county by dividing the number determined under subparagraph (M)  
37 of this paragraph for the county by the total of all numbers  
38 calculated under subparagraph (M) of this paragraph;

39  
40 (O) Determine the amount to distribute to each  
41 county by multiplying the normalized index number determined  
42 under subparagraph (N) of this paragraph by the amount remaining  
43 available for distribution under this paragraph."
