A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to state funded facilities; providing
2 appropriations for state funded capital construction for the
3 biennium commencing July 1, 2016 and ending June 30, 2018;
4 continuing and codifying state facility accounts as specified;
5 continuing the task force on department of health facilities;
6 providing definitions; providing for conditions and other
7 requirements related to state funded capital construction
8 appropriations; repealing provisions related to University of
9 Wyoming matching fund requirements in prior capital
10 construction appropriations; providing appropriations;
11 providing for carryover appropriations; and providing
12 effective date.

14 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

15

1 **Section 1.** W.S. 9-4-221 through 9-4-223 are created to
2 read:

3

4 **9-4-221. State facilities construction account created;**
5 **purposes.**

6

7 The state facilities construction account created by 2014
8 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 26, Section 300(h) is continued.
9 Funds within the account shall only be expended upon
10 legislative appropriation. All funds within the account shall
11 be invested by the state treasurer and all investment earnings
12 from the account shall be deposited to the account.

13

14 **9-4-222. University of Wyoming science initiative**
15 **account created; purposes.**

16

17 The University of Wyoming science initiative account created
18 by 2015 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 142, Section 317(c) is
19 continued. Funds within the account shall only be expended
20 upon legislative appropriation. All funds within the account
21 shall be invested by the state treasurer and all investment
22 earnings from the account shall be credited to the general
23 fund.

1

2 **9-4-223. Casper state facilities account created;**
3 **purposes.**

4

5 The Casper state facilities account created by 2015 Wyoming
6 Session Laws, Chapter 142, Section 346, footnote (f) is
7 continued. Funds within the account shall only be expended
8 upon legislative appropriation. All funds within the account
9 shall be invested by the state treasurer and all investment
10 earnings from the account shall be credited to the general
11 fund.

12

13 **Section 2.**

14

15 (a) As used in section 2 through section 9 of this act:

16

17 (i) "Appropriation" means the authorizations
18 granted by the legislature under this act to make expenditures
19 from and to incur obligations against the general and other
20 funds as specified;

21

22 (ii) "Approved budget" means an approved budget as
23 defined by W.S. 9-2-1005(e);

1

2 (iii) "FF" means federal funds;

3

4 (iv) "PR" means private funding sources;

5

6 (v) "SR" means an agency's account within the
7 special revenue fund;

8

9 (vi) "S0" means other funds identified by footnote;

10

11 (vii) "T5" means the penitentiary permanent land
12 fund;

13

14 (viii) "Unappropriated, unobligated and
15 unrestricted federal funds" means funds received by the state
16 of Wyoming from the federal government which:

17

18 (A) The receipt of which is not conditioned or
19 required by federal law, rule or regulation to be expended on
20 a purpose other than one authorized in this act;

21

22 (B) Are not required by Wyoming law to be
23 expended for a purpose other than projects undertaken pursuant

1 to title 24, title 35, article 11 of Wyoming statutes or one
2 authorized in this act; and

3

4 (C) By Wyoming law are to be deposited to the
5 general fund, the Wyoming highway fund, or an account created
6 by Wyoming law and from which funds may only be appropriated
7 upon further action of the legislature.

8

9 [CAPITAL CONSTRUCTION]

10

11 **Section 3.**

12

13 (a) The following sums of money are appropriated for the
14 capital construction projects specified. Appropriations for
15 these projects remain in effect until the project is
16 completed. Appropriated funds under this section shall be
17 expended only on the projects specified and any unused funds
18 remaining at project completion shall revert to the accounts
19 from which they were appropriated. The amounts appropriated in
20 this section are intended to provide a maximum amount for each
21 project and shall not be construed to be an entitlement or
22 guaranteed amount:

28 1. This appropriation shall be deposited into the Casper state facilities account
 29 and expended pursuant to Option 2 as requested in the department of administration
 30 and information's 2017-2018 biennial budget request with adjacent surface parking.

1

2 2. As a condition of this appropriation, the applicable college must expend the
3 entire appropriation of other funds prior to the release of any general funds
4 appropriated for purposes of the authorized capital construction project.

5

6 3. Of these federal and other funds appropriations, funds may be expended for
7 rehabilitation of existing facilities, but no funds shall be expended for the
8 construction of new facilities without further legislative authorization.

9

10 4. Funds from this appropriation shall be deposited in the state facilities
11 construction account.

12

13 5. This appropriation shall only be expended upon approval of the state building
14 commission for land acquisition purchases pursuant to Option 2 as requested in the
15 department of administration and information's 2017-2018 biennial budget request
16 with adjacent surface parking.

14 1. The state treasurer shall deposit this appropriation into the University of
15 Wyoming science initiative account.

16

17 (b) (i) Except as provided in paragraph (ii) of this
18 subsection, general funds appropriated in this section shall
19 only be released for purposes of expenditure when a like
20 amount of unappropriated, unobligated and unrestricted federal
21 funds have been received by the state of Wyoming in the fiscal
22 biennium commencing July 1, 2016 as certified by the governor
23 and determined by the state auditor. Upon certification and
24 determination of the receipt and deposit of such federal
25 funds, general funds appropriated in section 2 of this act

1 shall be made available for expenditure in the following
2 order:

3

4 (A) Eleven million five hundred thousand
5 dollars (\$11,500,000.00) for the Engineering Building I;

6

7 (B) One million dollars (\$1,000,000.00) for
8 the West Campus Energy Plant;

9

10 (C) Forty-five million dollars
11 (\$45,000,000.00) for the Dept. of Health - Facs. I;

12

13 (D) Five million three hundred seventy-nine
14 thousand eight hundred forty-nine dollars (\$5,379,849.00) for
15 the OSLI - Forestry Level III;

16

17 (E) Thirteen million dollars (\$13,000,000.00)
18 for A&I - State Fac. - Casper I;

19

20 (F) Five million two hundred fifty thousand
21 dollars (\$5,250,000.00) for CC - CWC Ag/Animal Science;

22

1 (G) Six million five hundred thousand dollars
2 (\$6,500,000.00) for the CC - NWCCD Tech Ed Ctr.;

3

4 (H) Twenty-five million dollars
5 (\$25,000,000.00) for the Dept. of Health - Facs. II;

6

7 (J) Fifty-one million two hundred thousand
8 dollars (\$51,200,000.00) for the UW Science Initiative;

9

10 (K) Three million dollars (\$3,000,000.00) for
11 Property Purchases; and

12

13 (M) Three hundred thousand dollars
14 (\$300,000.00) for UW Med Ed - WWAMI Level II.

16 (ii) The restrictions and conditions in paragraph
17 (i) of this subsection shall not apply to:

18

19 (A) One million four hundred eighty-six
20 thousand five hundred twenty-six dollars (\$1,486,526.00) of
21 general funds appropriated for the Forestry Level III Project;
22 and

23

1 (B) Three million dollars (\$3,000,000.00) of
2 general funds appropriated for the Engineering Building II;

3

4 (C) Seven million dollars (\$7,000,000.00) of
5 general funds appropriated for the A&I - State Fac. - Casper
6 II for land acquisition purchases.

7

8 (iii) Federal funds certified by the governor and
9 determined by the state auditor to have met the requirements
10 of paragraph (i) of this subsection, shall be deposited to the
11 general fund if not otherwise provided by law.

12

13 [DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH FACILITIES TASK FORCE]

14

15 **Section 4.**

16

17 (a) The joint legislative and executive task force on
18 department of health facilities created in 2014 Wyoming
19 Session Laws, Chapter 26, Section 329 as amended by 2015
20 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 142 is hereby continued.

21

22 (b) The task force shall be comprised of:

23

1 (i) Three (3) members of the senate, appointed by
2 the president of the senate;

3

4 (ii) Three (3) members of the house of
5 representatives, appointed by the speaker of the house;

6

7 (iii) Two (2) members of executive branch
8 departments appointed by the governor. In considering
9 appointments to the task force who are not members of the
10 legislature, the governor shall consider the expertise
11 required to procure a Level III design study and evaluate
12 options for the Wyoming retirement center as provided in this
13 section.

14

15 (c) The task force shall implement the recommendations
16 for its 2016 work as provided in the January 7, 2016
17 department of health facilities task force final report on
18 file with the legislative service office, including:

19

20 (i) Procuring and supervising a Level III design
21 study for the Wyoming state hospital and the Wyoming life
22 resource center; and

23

1 (ii) Evaluating potential options for the
2 management and ownership structure of the Wyoming retirement
3 center;

4

5 (iii) Providing interim reports on the activities
6 of the task force to the joint appropriations committee and
7 the joint labor, health and social services interim committee
8 not later than November 1, 2016 and November 1, 2017;

9

10 (iv) Providing recommendations for legislative
11 action.

12

13 (d) The task force shall be staffed by the legislative
14 service office. The department of administration and
15 information shall serve in an advisory capacity to the task
16 force and shall provide technical and other relevant
17 information as requested.

18

19 (e) Recommendations of the task force created by this
20 section shall be submitted for legislative action to the joint
21 appropriations committee and the joint labor, health and
22 social services interim committee not later than June 30,
23 2018.

1

2 (f) The task force may contract with experts as
3 necessary to fulfill the duties assigned under this section
4 upon majority vote of the task force and with the approval of
5 the governor. No contract under this subsection shall be
6 subject to the procurement provisions of W.S. 9-2-1016.

7

8 (g) The task force shall terminate on June 30, 2018.

9

10 (h) There is appropriated forty thousand dollars
11 (\$40,000.00) from the general fund to the legislative service
12 office. This appropriation shall be for the period beginning
13 with the effective date of this act and ending June 30, 2018.
14 This appropriation shall only be expended for the purpose of
15 funding salary, mileage and per diem of legislative members of
16 the task force. Notwithstanding any other provision of law,
17 this appropriation shall not be transferred or expended for
18 any other purpose and any unexpended, unobligated funds
19 remaining from this appropriation shall revert as provided by
20 law on June 30, 2018.

21

22 (j) There is appropriated nine million dollars
23 (\$9,000,000.00) from the state facilities construction account

1 to the department of administration and information to
2 procure, develop and implement the Level III design study as
3 approved by the department of health facilities task force.
4

5 [WYOMING STATE VETERINARY BIOSAFETY LEVEL III LABORATORY]
6

7 **Section 5.** In addition to the authority provided under
8 W.S. 9-1-417 the state treasurer and the state auditor shall
9 direct a no interest loan from the state's risk management
10 pool to the department of administration and information
11 construction management program within the general services
12 division as he determines necessary for repairs to the Wyoming
13 state veterinary biosafety level III laboratory. The division
14 may expend the funds as necessary to fully commission the
15 laboratory space. Proceeds collected from insurers and third
16 parties for the repairs shall be used to repay the loan. The
17 attorney general, department of administration and information
18 and the University of Wyoming shall coordinate efforts to
19 recover damages to the Wyoming state veterinary biosafety
20 level III laboratory.
21

1 [CARRYOVER APPROPRIATIONS - LAND ACQUISITION - HONOR FARM]

2

3 **Section 6.** Notwithstanding W.S. 9-2-1008, 9-2-1012(e)
4 and 9-4-207(a), of unobligated monies appropriated from the
5 general fund to the department of corrections under 2015
6 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 142, Section 348 for land
7 acquisition at the honor farm, two hundred fifty thousand
8 dollars (\$250,000.00) or as much thereof as is available shall
9 not revert, and is hereby reappropriated to the department of
10 corrections for the period ending June 30, 2018 to purchase
11 replacement property necessary for the department to carry on
12 the institutional mission of the honor farm after the disposal
13 of three hundred two and eighteen hundredths (302.18) acres of
14 department of corrections' acquired institutional lands in
15 Fremont County. These funds shall only be expended if the
16 proceeds received from the sale of the department of
17 corrections' acquired institutional lands is insufficient to
18 purchase replacement property that would allow the department
19 to carry out its mission in a substantially similar manner.
20 Proceeds from the disposal of three hundred two and eighteen
21 hundredths (302.18) acres of department of corrections
22 acquired institutional lands in Fremont County are
23 appropriated for land acquisition at the honor farm.

Section 9. In addition to the authority provided under W.S. 9-1-417 the state treasurer and the state auditor may utilize interfund loans from the unexpended, unobligated balance of the one percent severance tax account for deposit to the strategic investments and projects account as necessary to meet appropriations from that account and contract obligations of the department of administration and University of Wyoming incurred for purposes of this act.

[DEPOSIT OF REVERSIONS TO CAPITOL BUILDING REHABILITATION

Section 10. Any unexpended, unobligated appropriations from the general fund or budget reserve account remaining in a capital construction project budget upon completion of the project shall be deposited into the capitol building rehabilitation and restoration account created by W.S. 9-5-109(j) and shall not be transferred or expended for any other purpose. Any reversion of unexpended, unobligated funds in any capital construction budget contained in any prior

1 capital construction appropriation from the general fund or
2 budget reserve account, which occurs prior to July 1, 2018,
3 shall also be deposited into the capitol building
4 rehabilitation and restoration account, unless the
5 appropriation specified another use of the reverted funds.

9 **Section 11.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law,
10 of unobligated, unexpended monies from the two million one
11 hundred seventy-three thousand five hundred dollar
12 (\$2,173,500.00) appropriation from the general fund to the
13 department of corrections pursuant to 2004 Wyoming Session
14 Laws, Chapter 95, Section 3, Section 080, for purposes of WSP
15 - North Facility Demolition and the one hundred fifty thousand
16 dollar (\$150,000.00) appropriation to the department of
17 administration and information pursuant to 2009 Wyoming
18 Session Laws, Chapter 159, Section 3, Section 006, for
19 purposes of DOC - North Indust. Bldg. Renov., nine hundred
20 twenty-nine thousand nine hundred forty-seven dollars
21 (\$929,947.00) is reappropriated to the department of
22 administration and information for flooring system renovation
23 at the Wyoming honor conservation camp, Wyoming women's center

1 and Wyoming medium correctional institution and nine hundred
2 ninety thousand dollars (\$990,000.00) is reappropriated to the
3 department of state parks and cultural resources for design
4 and infrastructure installation for interpretative exhibits in
