Enterprise technology services amendments.

Sponsored by: Joint Appropriations Committee

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to the administration of government;  
2 amending provisions related to the department of enterprise  
3 technology; requiring application to the federal universal  
4 service fund and requiring deposit of funds received in the  
5 school foundation account; providing conditions for  
6 replacement of computers under the state chief information  
7 officer's computer replacement program; providing  
8 conditions and limitations on a state government unified  
9 telecommunications network; and providing for an effective  
10 date.

12 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

13

14 **Section 1.** W.S. 9-2-2906(d) by creating a paragraph  
15 (v), (e) by creating a paragraph (v) and (n) is amended to  
16 read:

2           **9-2-2906. Office of the state chief information**  
3 **officer and director; authority; duties of department.**

5           (d) The department shall carry out the following  
6 oversight and approval functions:

7

8                   (v) All computer purchases made via the chief  
9 information officer's state technology replacement program  
10 shall be made in accordance with the provisions of this  
11 subsection, using standardized pricing established by the  
12 program. All funds appropriated for computer acquisition  
13 shall be restricted and not expended for any other purpose.

15           (e) The department shall provide the following  
16 services:

17

18                   (v) The department shall annually apply to the  
19 universal service administrative company under the federal  
20 communications commission for amounts available to the  
21 state under the schools and libraries program of the  
22 universal service fund. All federal funds received by the  
23 state from the schools and libraries program of the

1 universal service fund shall be deposited into the school  
2 foundation program account.

3  
4 (n) Nothing in this article shall be construed to  
5 authorize the department or the director to regulate or  
6 otherwise have any jurisdiction or authority over  
7 nongovernmental providers of telecommunications services or  
8 broadband services. Nothing in this article shall be  
9 construed to authorize the department or the state to be a  
10 telecommunications services provider to the private sector.

11 To the extent a network to provide telecommunications  
12 transport services for state government and higher  
13 education is developed and implemented under subsection (g)  
14 of this section, rather than purchasing facilities or  
15 providing its own communications services for the creation  
16 and operation of the unified network, the state of Wyoming  
17 shall purchase services from commercial communications  
18 carriers to the fullest extent reasonably feasible. Such a  
19 network is limited to use only by:

20  
21 (i) The executive, legislative and judicial  
22 branches of Wyoming state government, including the  
23 University of Wyoming and community colleges. In relation

1 to use of this network, "Wyoming state government" does not  
2 include local government, cities, towns, counties,  
3 hospitals, joint powers boards, special districts or other  
4 local governmental entities; and

5  
6 (ii) Wyoming public schools and public  
7 libraries.

8  
9 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2017.
