## **Summary/Major Elements:**

- This bill establishes that neither a franchisee nor a franchisee's employee is an employee of a franchisor for the purposes of the state's unemployment compensation program, worker's compensation program, or other provisions of Title 27 of the Wyoming Statutes.
- This bill provides exceptions to this rule:
  - If the franchisor and franchisee agree otherwise in writing; and
  - Pursuant to an agreement between the United States Department of Labor and a franchisee.
