A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to labor and employment; amending the
2 surety bond or other security requirements for nonresident
3 employers; and providing for an effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 27-1-106(a) and (b) is amended to
8 read:

10 **27-1-106. Certain nonresident employers required to**
11 **post bond; exceptions.**

13 (a) All firms, corporations or employers of any kind
14 who are nonresident employers and expect to pay wages in
15 the state of Wyoming in excess of ~~ten thousand dollars~~

1 ~~(\$10,000.00) monthly or one hundred twenty thousand dollars~~
2 ~~(\$120,000.00) annually~~ four thousand dollars (\$4,000.00) in
3 any month as a result of conducting business within
4 Wyoming, are required to file with the director of the
5 department of workforce services a surety bond or other
6 security meeting the requirements of this section, approved
7 by the director. ~~and the attorney general.~~

8
9 (b) The bond or other security required by subsection
10 (a) of this section shall be in the amount of ~~twenty~~
11 ~~thousand dollars (\$20,000.00)~~ eight thousand dollars
12 (\$8,000.00) plus an additional two thousand dollars
13 (\$2,000.00) for each ~~one hundred twenty thousand dollars~~
14 ~~(\$120,000.00)~~ one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) or fraction
15 thereof that the expected wages in any month exceed ~~one~~
16 ~~hundred twenty thousand dollars (\$120,000.00) annually.~~
17 four thousand dollars (\$4,000.00) up to expected wages in
18 any month of twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000.00). For
19 expected wages in any month that exceed twenty thousand
20 dollars (\$20,000.00), the bond or other security amount
21 shall be one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) for each
22 additional one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) or fraction
23 thereof of expected wages.
