A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to prioritization of municipal solid waste  
2 facilities cease and transfer projects; authorizing  
3 expenditure of previously appropriated funds; establishing  
4 a prioritized list of projects; establishing a maximum  
5 amount to be expended on projects; granting the department  
6 of environmental quality limited discretionary authority to  
7 modify the prioritized list; providing definitions;  
8 repealing a prior list of priority cease and transfer  
9 projects; and providing for an effective date.

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11 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

13 **Section 1.**

15 (a) As used in this section:

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2 (i) "Maximum amount" means the total amount to  
3 be expended on the listed project and reflects one hundred  
4 percent (100%) of the project cost, including any award by  
5 the state loan and investment board under W.S. 35-11-528;

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7 (ii) "(C)" means closure project;

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9 (iii) "SWDD" means solid waste disposal  
10 district;

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12 (iv) "(T)" means transfer projects.

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14 (b) From amounts appropriated by 2013 Wyoming Session  
15 Laws, Chapter 194, Section 2(a) and (b), 2014 Wyoming  
16 Session Laws, Chapter 26, Section 333(a) and (b), 2015  
17 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 142, Section 345 (priority  
18 2), 2016 Session Laws, Chapter 31, Section 316(a), and  
19 other funds appropriated and authorized for program  
20 expenses, the following amounts and prioritized projects  
21 are authorized pursuant to the municipal solid waste  
22 facilities cease and transfer program created by W.S.  
23 35-11-528:

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16           (c) The department of environmental quality may  
17 modify the authorized funds and the order of the projects  
18 listed in the prioritized list contained in subsection (b)  
19 of this section for any of the following reasons:

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21                   (i) To optimize efficiency;

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23                   (ii) Based on project readiness;

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2 (iii) Based on compliance with grant or loan  
3 qualifications or conditions;

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5 (iv) To address emergency or immediate  
6 environmental concerns.

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8 (d) Not later than October 15 of each year, the  
9 department of environmental quality shall report any  
10 modification of the prioritized list contained in  
11 subsection (b) of this section to the joint minerals,  
12 business and economic development interim committee and the  
13 joint appropriations committee.

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15 **Section 2.** 2017 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 32 is  
16 repealed.

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18 **Section 3.** This act is effective immediately upon  
19 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law  
20 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming  
21 Constitution.
