## A BILL

for

1	AN ACT relating to commercial vehicles; specifying
2	applicability of federal rules requiring electronic logging
3	devices in Wyoming; preventing Wyoming officers from
4	enforcing specified federal requirements; requiring
5	rulemaking; and providing for an effective date.
6	
7	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:
8	
9	Section 1. W.S. 31-18-303 by creating new subsections
10	(f) and (g) is amended to read:
11	
12	31-18-303. Authority of department to adopt rules and
13	regulations governing drivers, equipment and hazardous
14	materials; exceptions; maximum operating hours.

2	(f) The department shall adopt rules according to
3	this subsection prescribing the permissible operating time
4	and other requirements of motor carrier drivers and
5	equipment standards that allow specified motor carrier
6	drivers in Wyoming to complete paper records of duty status
7	and that do not require electronic logging devices (ELDs),
8	notwithstanding requirements to make rules consistent with
9	United States department of transportation rules and
10	regulations as provided in subsections (a) and (c) of this
11	section. A motor carrier driver operating in Wyoming and
12	complying with department rules shall comprise substantial
13	compliance with federal requirements. Department rules
14	shall:
15	
16	(i) Apply to motor carrier drivers of commercial
17	motor vehicles, as defined in 49 C.F.R. 390.5, within the
18	state of Wyoming not participating in interstate commerce
19	who are required to keep records of duty status;
20	
21	(ii) Apply to livestock and agriculture
22	commodity haulers within the state of Wyoming hauling their

1	own goods or participating in sanctioned rodeo, horse
2	racing or agricultural events;
3	
4	(iii) Apply to motor carrier drivers within the
5	state of Wyoming who use paper logs no more than eight (8)
6	days during any thirty (30) day period or no more than
7	ninety-six (96) days during any calendar year;
8	
9	(iv) Apply to driveaway-towaway drivers within
10	the state of Wyoming transporting a vehicle for sale, lease
11	or repair;
12	
13	(v) Apply to motor carrier drivers within the
14	state of Wyoming of vehicles manufactured or containing two
15	(2) or more components manufactured before model year 2000;
16	
17	(vi) Specify that nonuse of an ELD shall not
18	invalidate any other safety inspections; and
19	
20	(vii) Not prevent an individual or business
21	entity of any kind from voluntarily complying with federal
22	laws involving ELDs.

1	(g) No officer, as defined in W.S. 31-1-203(a) or
2	31-5-102(a)(xxxiii), shall enforce in Wyoming any rule or
3	regulation that requires an electronic logging device that
4	applies to an operator in paragraphs (f)(i) through (v) of
5	this section, except as provided in subsection (f) of this
6	section and department rules promulgated according to
7	subsection (f) of this section.
8	
9	Section 2. This act is effective immediately upon
10	completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
11	as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
12	Constitution.
