15 section, the maximum individual award of compensation paid to

16 any victim or dependent shall not exceed fifteen thousand

- 1 dollars (\$15,000.00). Compensation shall only be awarded for
- 2 <u>economic losses occurring within a twenty-four (24) month</u>
- 3 period from the date of the injury or discovery of the crime.
- 4 However, the division may extend the twenty-four (24) month
- 5 period to allow compensation for mental health counseling and
- 6 care occurring within an additional twelve (12) month period
- 7 <u>for a total of thirty-six (36) months.</u>

- 9 (e) In addition to the maximum award authorized in
- 10 subsection (d) of this section, in the case of catastrophic
- 11 injury the division may award an additional amount not to
- 12 exceed ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) to the victim to
- 13 cover future lost wages, special medical needs and any other
- 14 special assistance needed as a result of the injury. The
- 15 additional award may be made only for losses and expenses
- 16 <u>economic losses</u> occurring within twenty-four (24) months
- 17 after the date of the injury or discovery of the crime.
