## A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to criminal history records; requiring

2 individuals certified by the professional teaching standards

3 board to submit to a criminal history record background check

4 every five years after initial certification; requiring

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12 No certification shall be issued under this section 13 until a criminal history background check has been filed with 14 and received by the board, the applicant provides a release 15 of information and the applicant consents to the release of 16 any criminal history information to the board and if applicable, to the employing school district. Individuals 17 certified by the board under this section shall, as a 18 19 condition of continued certification, also submit to a 20 criminal history record background check every five (5) years 21 as provided in this subsection. Upon receipt of a background report pursuant to this subsection indicating that the 22 applicant or certified individual has a conviction equal to 23

1 a felony under Wyoming law or any conviction for an act which 2 would constitute a violation under chapter 2 or chapter 4 of 3 title 6 of the Wyoming statutes, the board shall immediately 4 provide a copy of the report to the employing local school board if the information involves a certified individual 5 employed by that local board and if the local board has 6 requested a copy of the report. For all persons seeking 7 8 initial certification under this section on or after July 1, 1996 required to submit to a criminal history record 9 10 background check pursuant to this section:

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12 The applicant or certified individual shall be 13 required to verify under oath whether he has been convicted of a felony. The board may deny or revoke certification of 14 any applicant or certified individual who has been convicted 15 16 of a felony that relates to the practice of teaching or to 17 the ability to practice as a teacher and may annul a 18 certificate for misrepresentation by an applicant 19 certified individual of his criminal history. Any felony 20 related to a sexual offense shall be considered to relate to 21 the practice of teaching. Action by the board to revoke or annul a certificate shall be taken following a hearing 22 conducted in accordance with the Wyoming Administrative 23

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1 Procedure Act, unless the person holding the certification 2 waives the right to a hearing; 3 4 (ii) The applicant or certified individual shall provide to the board fingerprints and other information 5 necessary for a criminal history record background check as 6 7 provided in W.S. 7-19-201(a). 8 9 33-33-102. Definitions. 10 (a) As used in this act: 11 12 13 (ix) "Speech-language pathology assistant" means 14 an individual who meets minimum qualifications established by 15 this act and board rule rules for speech-language pathology 16 assistants and who works under the supervision of a licensed 17 speech-language pathologist. A speech-language pathology 18 assistant may: 19 20 33-33-105. Eligibility for licensing. 21 (b) In addition to any other applicable requirements 22

specified by this act or board rules, to be eligible for

- 1 <u>licensing</u> by the board as a speech-language pathologist or
- 2 speech-language pathology assistant, a person shall provide
- 3 to the board fingerprints and other information necessary for
- 4 a criminal history record background check, as required by
- 5 W.S. 7-19-201.

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- 7 **Section 2.** The professional teaching standards board
- 8 shall, as a condition of continued certification pursuant to
- 9 W.S. 21-2-802(e), establish a rolling schedule to conduct
- 10 criminal history background checks on individuals holding a
- 11 certification from the board on or before the effective date
- 12 of this act. Background checks conducted by the board pursuant
- 13 to this section shall be completed by July 1, 2024 and every
- 14 fifth year subsequent to the date of a background check
- 15 conducted under this section, consistent with W.S.
- 16 21-2-802(e).

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- 18 Section 3. This act is effective immediately upon
- 19 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law as
- 20 provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming Constitution.
