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9 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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11 **Section 1.** W.S. 21-18-205(f) is amended to read:

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21-18-205. Appropriation and distribution of state

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14 funds; restrictions; budget authority.

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1 (f) Up to eight percent (8%) fifteen percent (15%) of 2 each community college's unrestricted operating funds for a 3 biennium may be carried forward into the next biennium by 4 each community college. The cumulative total amount of 5 unrestricted operating funds carried forward from previous 6 bienniums shall never exceed eight percent (8%) fifteen percent (15%) of the community college's current biennium 7 8 unrestricted operating funds. Funds carried forward in 9 accordance with this subsection shall not lapse pursuant to 10 W.S. 9-4-207. 11 12 **Section 2.** W.S. 21-15-109(b) and 21-18-225(k) 13 amended to read: 14 15 21-15-109. Major building and facility repair and 16 replacement payments; computation; square footage allowance; 17 use of payment funds; accounting and reporting requirements. 18 19 To the extent funds are available, on July 1 of 20 each year, the state construction department shall, based 21 upon square footage computations computed from the prior 22 school year, distribute seventy five percent (75%) of the 23 estimated major building and facility repair and replacement

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1	payments in quarterly installments to each school district
2	from the school capital construction account. On or before
3	September 30 of each year the department shall distribute the
4	balance of payments to each school district. The department
5	shall distribute the first quarterly payment on July 1 of
6	each fiscal year, with the remaining payments distributed on
7	October 1, January 2 and April 1. Payments shall be made as
8	equal as reasonably possible. If funds within the account
9	are not sufficient for payments of any school year any
10	quarterly payment, the department shall reduce all district
11	payments for that quarter by a uniform percentage. The
12	department shall also increase or reduce a subsequent school
13	district payment, as appropriate, in the event a school
14	district receives an excessive or deficient distribution.
15	Major building and facility repair and replacement payments
16	shall be computed in accordance with subsection (c) of this

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section.

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22 (k) Appropriations for major maintenance shall be 23 distributed by the state construction department to community

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1 colleges <u>in equal quarterly installments</u> in amounts

2 determined by the funding formula developed by the state

3 building commission, subject to restrictions imposed on

4 qualifying square footage pursuant to this section. The state

5 construction department shall distribute the first quarterly

6 payment on July 1 of each fiscal year, with the remaining

7 payments distributed on October 1, January 2 and April 1.
