- 8 **Section 1.** W.S. 1-26-813 and 36-9-118 are amended to

- 14 (a) Corporations authorized to do business in this
- 15 state for the purpose of constructing, maintaining and

operating a public utility or communications company may set

their fixtures and facilities along, across or under any of 2 3 the public roads, streets and waters of this state in such 4 manner as not to inconvenience the public in their use. Any 5 public utility or communications company desiring to install its facilities in any city shall first attempt to obtain 6 consent from the city council in accordance with applicable 7 8 law. A person shall first obtain permission from the state 9 transportation commission or the board of commissioners in the county where the construction is 10 11 contemplated before entering upon any state highway or county 12 road for the purpose of commencing the construction. 13 (b) As used in this section, "communications company" 14 15 means a person, or any agent, contractor or subcontractor of 16 the person, who in the course of business, provides services 17 which are telecommunications services, as defined in W.S. 39-15-101(a)(xxxix)(U), internet protocol enabled service or 18 voice over internet protocol. As used in this section: 19 20 21 (i) "Internet protocol enabled service" means any service, capability, functionality or application, other than 22 voice over internet protocol service, using existing internet 23

	protocol, or any successor internet protocol, that enables an
2	end user to send or receive a communication in existing
3	internet protocol format, or any successor internet protocol
4	format, utilizing a broadband connection at the end user's
5	location, regardless of whether the communication is voice,
6	data or video;

8	(ii) "Voice over internet protocol service" means
9	any service that:
10	
11	(A) Enables real time, two-way voice
12	communication originating from or terminating at the user's
13	location in internet protocol or a successor protocol;
14	
15	(B) Utilizes a broadband connection at the
16	user's location; and

18	(C) Permits a user to receive a call that
19	originates on the public switched telephone network and to
20	terminate a call to the public switched telephone network.
