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5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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7 **Section 1.** W.S. 15-1-110(b)(i) and 18-3-516(b)(i) are

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10 15-1-110. Minutes of meetings and titles of ordinances

11 passed to be published; exception; contents; publication of

12 salaries and wages of specified officials and employees.

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14 (b) A city or town required to publish minutes under

15 subsection (a) of this section shall separately publish:

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2 (i) Within sixty (60) days after the end of each 3 fiscal year, the name, position and gross monthly salary, 4 excluding name, of each all full-time employee employees and 5 each elected official of the city or town. A brief statement shall accompany the salary publication specifying 6 that all salaries are listed as gross monthly salaries or 7 actual monthly wages, not including any fringe benefits such 8 9 as health insurance costs, life insurance benefits and 10 pension plans. The statement shall also indicate that the 11 salaries or wages do not include any overtime the an employee 12 may earn which would be paid by the city or town;

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14 18-3-516. Publication of proceedings; publication of 15 salaries and wages of certain officials and employees.

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(b) Each board of county commissioners shall post on the county's official website in the manner provided in subsection (f) of this section and publish separate from the minutes of the proceedings:

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22 (i) Within sixty (60) days after the end of each 23 fiscal year, the name, position and gross monthly salary.

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1 excluding name, of each all full-time employee employees and each elected official officials of the county. A brief 2 statement shall accompany the salary publication specifying 3 4 that all salaries are listed as gross monthly salaries or actual monthly wages, not including any fringe benefits such 5 as health insurance costs, life insurance benefits and 6 7 pension plans. The statement shall also indicate that the 8 salaries or wages do not include any overtime that the an 9 employee may earn which would be paid by the county. 10 Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2019. 11
