Lifetime fishing licenses for permanently disabled persons.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to game and fish; authorizing the game and
2 fish commission to issue lifetime complimentary fishing
3 licenses and conservation stamps for permanently and totally
4 disabled residents as specified; requiring rulemaking; and
5 providing for effective dates.

7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8

9 **Section 1.** W.S. 23-1-302 by creating a new subsection
10 (q), 23-1-504(a)(iv), (v) and by creating a new paragraph
11 (vi) and 23-2-306(a)(intro) are amended to read:

13 **23-1-302. Powers and duties.**

14

1 (g) The commission shall, by rule and regulation,
2 establish a process for issuing a resident lifetime fishing
3 license and conservation stamp at no cost to any resident who
4 is permanently and totally disabled.

5
6 **23-1-504. Free and reduced price license revenue**
7 **recoupment program.**

8
9 (a) Not later than July 31, 2007, and not later than
10 July 31 of each subsequent year thereafter, the chief fiscal
11 officer of the game and fish department shall prepare and
12 certify a report of licenses sold or issued in the previous
13 calendar year under the following statutes:

15 (iv) W.S. 23-1-705(a), (d), (e) and (h); ~~and~~

17 (v) W.S. 23-2-207(a); ~~and~~

19 (vi) W.S. 23-1-302(g).

21 **23-2-306. Conservation stamp; exemptions.**

22

1 (a) Subject to subsections (b) and (c) of this section
2 and the applicable fee under W.S. 23-1-701, each sportsman
3 licensed under W.S. 23-2-101, 23-2-107 or 23-2-201 shall
4 purchase a single conservation stamp for twelve dollars
5 (\$12.00) which shall be valid for the time period specified
6 in commission rules not to exceed twelve (12) months. The
7 stamp or an authorization signifying purchase of the stamp
8 shall be in the possession of any person exercising rights
9 under any fishing or hunting license issued pursuant to W.S.
10 23-2-101, 23-2-107 or 23-2-201. Holders of special limited
11 fishing permits issued under W.S. 23-2-207 and holders of
12 licenses only under W.S. 23-1-302(g), 23-2-101(j)(v) and
13 (vi), 23-2-201(d)(vi), (vii) and (ix), 23-2-201(f) and
14 23-2-201(g) are exempt from the provisions of this section
15 when exercising hunting or fishing privileges provided under
16 those specific licenses. Revenues collected from the sale of
17 each stamp under this subsection shall be deposited as
18 follows:

20 **Section 2.** The game and fish commission shall
21 promulgate any rules necessary to implement this act,
22 provided that these rules shall not take effect until July 1,
23 2019.

4 (a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section,
5 this act is effective July 1, 2019.

6

7 (b) Section 2 of this act is effective immediately upon
8 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law as
9 provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming Constitution.
