Driver's licenses-medical alert designation.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to driver's licenses; authorizing a medical
2 alert designation on a person's driver's license or
3 identification card; making conforming amendments; and
4 providing for an effective date.

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6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

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8 **Section 1.** W.S. 31-7-142 is created to read:

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10 **31-7-142. Medical alert designation.**

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12 The department shall, at the applicant's request, identify on
13 the Wyoming driver's license or identification card that the
14 person has a medical condition for which the person is
15 requesting a medical alert designation. No specific medical

1 information will be contained on the Wyoming driver's license
2 or identification card.

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4 **Section 2.** W.S. 31-7-111(b) by creating a new paragraph
5 (xiii), 31-7-115(a)(iii) by creating a new subparagraph (N),
6 31-7-118, 31-8-101(a) and 31-8-103(c)(intro) and (i) are
7 amended to read:

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9 **31-7-111. Application for license or permit generally.**

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11 (b) The application shall include:

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13 (xiii) Whether the applicant is requesting a
14 medical alert designation as provided for in W.S. 31-7-142.

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16 **31-7-115. Issuance, description and contents.**

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18 (a) Upon the satisfactory completion of any required
19 examination, the division shall issue to every qualifying
20 applicant a driver's license, and:

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22 (iii) The driver's license shall include, but not
23 be limited to, the following information:

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31-7-118. Replacement license.

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7 If a license issued under this act is lost, destroyed or if
8 the licensee desires to withdraw or insert notice of
9 anatomical organ donation or a medical alert designation, the
10 person may obtain the appropriate replacement license upon
11 payment of the proper fee and surrender of the original
12 license, if available.

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14 **31-8-101. Issuance to residents by department;**
15 **restrictions.**

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17 (a) Any Wyoming resident may be issued an
18 identification card by the department of transportation. The
19 application shall state the registrant's full legal name,
20 social security number, date of birth and any other
21 identifying data the department may require and shall be
22 signed and verified by the applicant. The identification
23 card shall at the applicant's request indicate that the

1 applicant is an anatomical organ donor as provided by W.S.
2 35-5-205 or that the applicant has a medical condition as
3 provided for in W.S. 31-7-142.

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5 **31-8-103. Expiration; records; new cards.**

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7 (c) If any information contained in the identification
8 card becomes inaccurate, or if it is desired to withdraw or
9 insert notice of anatomical organ donation or a medical alert
10 designation, the person to whom it was issued may obtain a
11 new card upon:

12

13 (i) Advising the department of his desire to
14 withdraw or insert notice of an anatomical organ donation or
15 a medical alert designation or furnishing proof of the
16 inaccuracies to the department;

17

18 **Section 3.** This act is effective July 1, 2019.
