A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to motor vehicles; extending the expiration  
2 date for driver's licenses as specified; and providing for an  
3 effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 31-7-119(a), (c), (f)(intro) and (i) is  
8 amended to read:

9

10 **31-7-119. Expiration and renewal; required tests;**  
11 **extension.**

13 (a) Every driver's license shall expire on the  
14 licensee's birthday in the ~~fourth~~fifth year following the  
15 issuance of the license.

2 (c) Notwithstanding subsection (f) of this section, the  
3 division may defer the expiration of the license of a licensee  
4 who is on active duty in the armed forces of the United States  
5 for successive ~~four (4)~~ five (5) year periods, upon terms and  
6 conditions as it may prescribe. The division may similarly  
7 defer the expiration of the license of the spouse or dependent  
8 child of the person in the armed forces if residing with that  
9 person.

10

11 (f) Once in any ~~eight (8)~~ ten (10) year period, a  
12 driver's license may be extended for a ~~four (4)~~ five (5) year  
13 period without the examination required by subsection (b) of  
14 this section for a licensee:

15

16 (i) Whose license has not been suspended or  
17 revoked in the ~~four (4)~~ five (5) years immediately preceding  
18 the date of license expiration;

19

20 **Section 2.** This act applies to licenses issued or  
21 renewed on or after July 1, 2019.

1           **Section 3.** This act is effective July 1, 2019.
