2	30, 2025, the minimum wage shall increase at the rate of
3	twenty-five cents (\$0.25) per annum effective on July 1 of

8	Section 3. This act is effective immediately upon
9	completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law as
10	provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming Constitution.
