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- 14 (e) No practitioner shall prescribe any opioid or
- 15 combination of opioids for acute pain to an opioid naive

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- 2 (14) day period. The board shall by rule establish reasonable
- 3 exceptions to this section, in consultation with other
- 4 professional licensing boards that license practitioners,
- 5 including exceptions for chronic pain, cancer treatment,
- 6 palliative care and other clinically appropriate exceptions.
- 7 As used in this subsection:

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- 9 (i) "Opioid" means an opiumlike compound that
- 10 binds to one (1) or more of the major opioid receptors in the
- 11 body;

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- (ii) "Opioid naive patient" means a patient who
- 14 has not had an active opioid prescription in the preceding
- 15 forty-five (45) day period.
