- 10 **Section 1.** W.S. 21-3-131(b)(x) and 31-5-507 by creating
- 11 new subsection (e) are amended to read:

13 21-3-131. School bus standards; operators; vehicle

1 (b) Each district shall establish and maintain minimum

2 standards for the operation of school buses, including:

4 (x) Effective school year 2016-2017, and each

5 school year thereafter, all school buses transporting

6 students to and from school and to and from student

7 activities, as defined under W.S. 21-13-320(b)(i) and (ii),

8 shall be equipped with an external video system and may be

9 equipped with an internal video system. Equipment

10 specifications shall be prescribed by rule and regulation of

11 the department. Recordings or images from a video system

12 installed under this paragraph shall not be a public record

13 under the Wyoming Public Records Act, W.S. 16-4-201 through

14 16-4-205. Recordings or images may be entered into evidence

15 for a violation of W.S. 31-5-507(a) as provided in W.S.

16 31-5-507(e) and may be discoverable for other criminal

17 actions. Recordings or images made from a video system under

18 this paragraph shall be destroyed within one (1) year of the

19 <u>date the recording was made</u>.

1	(e) A recording of images produced by an external video
2	system equipped on a school bus under W.S. 21-3-131(b)(x)
3	shall be prima facie evidence of the facts contained in it.
4	A recorded image evidencing a violation of subsection (a) of
5	this section shall be admissible in a judicial or
6	administrative proceeding to adjudicate liability for the
7	violation. If the identity of the driver of a vehicle that
8	violates subsection (a) of this section is unknown, the
9	registered owner of the vehicle recorded by an external video
10	system as provided in this subsection shall be fined one
11	hundred ninety-five dollars (\$195.00) provided that:

13	(i) A fine issued to a registered owner of a
14	vehicle under this subsection shall not be considered a moving
15	violation for the purpose of suspending a driver's license
16	under W.S. 31-7-129 and shall not be considered a conviction
