A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to professions and occupations; renaming

2 the board of mixed martial arts as the Wyoming combat

3 sports commission; specifying duties of the commission

4 related to the governance of boxing; providing an

5 exemption; defining terms; renaming an account; making

6 conforming amendments; requiring rulemaking; specifying the

7 transfer of funds; and providing for an effective date.

9 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

10

11 **Section 1.** W.S. 33-48-101(a) through (g), (h)(ii) and

12 by creating new paragraphs (iv) and (v), 33-48-102(a), (b),

13 (c)(intro), (i) and (iii), 33-48-103 through 33-48-106,

14 33-48-107(a)(i) and (ii) and 33-48-108 through 33-48-116

15 are amended to read:

5	33-48-101. Wyoming combat sports commission created;
6	appointment; term; rules and regulations; definitions.
7	
8	(a) The state board of mixed martial arts <u>Wyomin</u>e
9	combat sports commission is created to implement and
LO	administer this chapter.

L2	(b) The board <u>commission</u> shall consist of three (3)
L3	members.
L 4	
L5	(c) Terms of initial board <u>commission</u> members shall
L6	be staggered with one (1) member serving for one (1) year,
L7	one (1) serving for two (2) years and one (1) serving for
L8	three (3) years.
L9	
20	(d) The governor shall appoint the members of the
21	board commission. Except for initial board commission
22	members as provided under subsection (c) of this section,
23	the term of each member shall be three (3) years. Upor

- 1 expiration of their terms, members of the board commission
- 2 shall continue to hold office until the appointment of
- 3 their successors. No person shall serve as a member of the
- 4 board for more than two (2) consecutive terms.

- 6 (e) A vacancy that occurs for any reason in the
- 7 membership of the **board commission** shall be filled within
- 8 thirty (30) days by the governor. A person appointed to
- 9 fill a vacancy shall serve for the unexpired portion of the
- 10 term.

11

- 12 (f) The governor may remove any member of the board
- 13 commission as provided in W.S. 9-1-202 or upon a
- 14 recommendation of a majority of the $\frac{\text{board}}{\text{commission}}$ for
- 15 any reason.

16

- 17 (g) The board commission shall adopt a seal and shall
- 18 make rules for the administration of this chapter.

19

20 (h) As used in this chapter:

21

- 22 (ii) "Mixed martial arts" means unarmed combat
- 23 involving the use, subject to any limitations set forth in

- 1 this chapter or by rule of the **board** commission, of a
- 2 combination of techniques from different disciplines of the
- 3 martial arts including, without limitation, grappling,
- 4 submission holds, kicking and striking;

- 6 (iv) "Boxing" means boxing, sparring or any form
- 7 of competition in which a blow is usually struck that may
- 8 reasonably be expected to inflict injury and where the only
- 9 authorized strikes are punches using padded gloves over the
- 10 hands;

11

- 12 (v) "Commission" means the Wyoming combat sports
- 13 commission.

14

- 33-48-102. Wyoming combat sports commission; powers
- 16 and duties; subpoenas; oaths.

- 18 (a) The board commission shall keep a full and
- 19 accurate record of all acts and doings of the board
- 20 <u>commission</u>. The <u>board commission</u> shall prepare for service
- 21 of notices and other papers as may be necessary and shall
- 22 have the power to administer oaths and issue subpoenas in
- 23 all matters pertaining to the administration of the board's

1 <u>commission's</u> duties. Falsely swearing before the board

2 <u>commission</u> shall be attended by the same consequences and

3 be subject to the same penalties as if the disobedience or

4 false swearing occurred in an action in the district court.

5

6 (b) A majority of the board commission constitutes a
7 quorum for meetings and the transaction of business. The
8 act of the majority of members of the board commission
9 shall be the act of the board commission. The board
10 commission shall meet as often as needed, but not less than
11 four (4) times a year. The meetings shall be held in
12 accordance with W.S. 16-4-401 through 16-4-407. The board

15 (c) Any subpoena issued by the board commission shall 16 be subject to the following:

commission shall keep permanent records of its meetings.

17

18 (i) The subpoena shall describe the objects
19 required to be produced and shall prescribe a return date
20 within a reasonable period of time within which the objects
21 can be assembled and made available. If any tangible
22 materials subpoenaed are located outside of this state, the
23 person to whom the subpoena is issued shall make the

1 materials available to the **board** <u>commission</u> at a convenient

2 location;

3

4 (iii) If any party fails or refuses to obey a 5 subpoena, the attorney general may, upon request of the

6 board commission and reasonable notice to all affected

7 persons, apply to the district court for an order

8 compelling compliance.

9

10 33-48-103. Wyoming combat sports commission; per

11 diem; mileage.

12

13 **Board <u>Commission</u>** members shall receive as compensation the

14 salary, per diem and mileage allowance as allowed to state

15 legislators for each day or portion thereof in which they

16 are engaged in the performance of their duties, payments of

17 the same to be made out of the state mixed martial arts

18 board's Wyoming combat sports commission's appropriation.

19 Provided, that if any state officer is appointed to act as

20 a $\frac{\text{board}}{\text{commission}}$ member, compensation for the services

21 shall not be reimbursed except for any necessary expenses

22 incurred or paid subject to the submission of appropriate

23 receipts.

33-48-104. Wyoming combat sports commission; report
to legislature; repeal of chapter.

4

(a) The **board** commission shall make a full report to 5 joint travel, recreation, wildlife and cultural 6 resources interim committee of all proceedings during the 7 8 two (2) years preceding the first day of December before the beginning of the general session of the legislature. 9 10 The report shall contain a statement of persons, clubs, organizations or corporations issued licenses, the number 11 12 licenses revoked, suspended or denied, the gross 13 receipts from each person, club, organization or corporation, and other information and comments in relation 14 15 to the work of the board commission as public interest may 16 require.

17

(b) If the board commission raises fees pursuant to

W.S. 33-48-108(b) and determines that the money received

under this chapter remains insufficient to continue

operations, the board commission shall report that

information to the legislature and shall not request any

appropriation from the legislature. W.S. 33-48-101 through

- 1 33-48-117 are repealed, effective upon adjournment of the
- 2 first legislative session convened after the date a report
- 3 under this subsection is made.

5 33-48-105. Jurisdiction over mixed martial arts and

6 boxing matches and licenses; power of municipalities.

7

8 (a) The board commission shall have sole direction, management, control of, and jurisdiction over, all mixed 9 10 martial arts and boxing matches to be conducted, held or given within the state. No mixed martial arts or boxing 11 match shall be conducted, held or given within the state 12 13 except pursuant to a license granted by the commission and in accordance with the provisions of this 14 15 chapter and the rules and regulations of the board 16 commission. Every license shall be subject to such rules as 17 the **board** commission may prescribe. The **board** commission may, at its discretion, issue and for cause revoke, deny or 18 19 suspend a license to conduct, hold or give a mixed martial 20 arts or boxing match. The board commission shall have full 21 power and authority to limit the number of mixed martial 22 arts and boxing matches to be held or given by any person, 23 club, organization or corporation in this state.

- 1 provision of this chapter shall prevent any incorporated
- 2 city or town from prohibiting by ordinance any mixed
- 3 martial arts or boxing match, provided that no match shall
- 4 be held other than in compliance with this chapter.

- 6 (b) Any person, club, organization or corporation in
- 7 this state seeking to hold a boxing match may seek a
- 8 license for the match from another state's boxing
- 9 commission, agency or regulatory body, subject to approval
- 10 of the Wyoming combat sports commission. A license issued
- 11 pursuant to this subsection shall be subject to the rules
- 12 and regulations of the issuing state's regulatory body.

13

14 33-48-106. License application; fee and bond.

15

- 16 Application for a license to conduct mixed martial arts and
- 17 boxing matches shall be in writing, shall be addressed to
- 18 the **board** commission and shall be verified by the
- 19 individual promoter or by an officer of the club,
- 20 organization or corporation on whose behalf the application
- 21 is made. The application shall be accompanied by a fee as
- 22 established by the **board commission** in accordance with W.S.
- 23 33-1-201. The application shall show that the club,

- 1 organization or corporation has been in existence not less
- 2 than thirty (30) days. Before any license is issued under
- 3 this chapter to any person, club, organization or
- 4 corporation, the applicant shall file with the state
- 5 treasurer a bond in an amount established by the board
- 6 <u>commission</u>, not to exceed the greater of ten thousand
- 7 dollars (\$10,000.00) or the total estimated expenses
- 8 associated with the match, with good and sufficient surety,
- 9 conditioned for the faithful performance of the conditions
- 10 of this chapter. The applicant shall provide an estimate of
- 11 the expenses for the match based on matches held at venues
- 12 with similar audience capacity and other relevant factors.
- 13 The board commission shall verify that the application
- 14 contains a good faith estimate of anticipated expenses for
- 15 the match.

- 33-48-107. Report of person, club, organization or
- 18 corporation; admission fee to be paid.

- 20 (a) Every person, club, organization or corporation
- 21 which exercises any of the privileges conferred by this
- 22 chapter shall within seventy-two (72) hours after the
- 23 determination of every match:

(i) Furnish to the board commission, or its representative, a written report, verified by the individual promoter or an officer of the club, organization or corporation. The report shall show the number of tickets sold for the match, the amount of gross proceeds from the match and other matters as the board may prescribe; and

10 (ii) Pay to the board commission a fee of five
11 percent (5%) of its total gross receipts from the sale of
12 tickets of admission and admission fees to any mixed
13 martial arts or boxing match.

14

15 33-48-108. Disposition of fees.

16

17 (a) All money received by the board commission under
18 this chapter shall be deposited with the state treasurer
19 and credited to the mixed martial arts board Wyoming combat
20 sports commission account, which is hereby created.

21

22 (b) If at any time the <u>board commission</u> determines 23 that the money received under this chapter is insufficient

to continue operations without additional state funding, 1

2 the board commission shall increase fees in accordance with

3 33-1-201 to the extent required to continue

4 operations. If the **board** commission raises fees under this

subsection and the money received under this chapter 5

remains insufficient to continue operations, the board 6

commission shall provide a report to the legislature as 7

8 specified in W.S. 33-48-104(b).

10 33-48-109. Amateur matches.

11

12 Whenever an amateur mixed martial arts or boxing match is

13 held by any person, club, organization or corporation, and

the match is not for pecuniary profit, the license fee and 14

bond provisions of W.S. 33-48-106, the reporting and fee 15

16 provisions of W.S. 33 48 107, and the presence of a board

17 member and the or board representative provisions of W.S.

33-48-110 provisions of this chapter shall not apply. The 18

19 match shall, however, be subject to all other provisions of

20 this chapter and the rules and regulations of the board.

21

33-48-110. Commission representatives. 22

1 The board commission shall appoint official representatives 2 designated as **board commission** representatives for the 3 state. Each <u>board commission</u> representative shall receive 4 from the **board commission** a card authorizing him to act as 5 representative wherever the board commission designate him to act. Except as provided in W.S. 33-48-109, 6 7 board commission member or board commission 8 representative shall be present at all matches conducted 9 for pecuniary profit and see that the rules and regulations 10 of the board commission are strictly observed. A board 11 commission representative may also be present at the 12 counting of the gross receipts and, if present, shall without undue delay provide to the **board** commission the 13 14 written report received by the board commission 15 representative from the individual promoter or officer of 16 the club, organization or corporation showing the number of 17 tickets sold, the gross amount of proceeds and other 18 matters as the **board** commission may prescribe. The **board** 19 commission may establish compensation for, and pay, any 20 board commission representatives appointed under this section from fees deposited in the mixed martial arts board 21 Wyoming combat sports commission account in accordance with 22 W.S. 33-1-202 and this chapter. 23

2 33-48-111. Rules for conduct of matches.

3

4 (a) The **board** commission shall promulgate rules and regulations regarding the conduct of 5 matches not inconsistent with this chapter or the unified rules of 6 mixed martial arts and the unified rules of boxing adopted 7 8 by the association of boxing commissions.

9

10 (b) No betting or wagering at any mixed martial arts 11 or boxing match shall be permitted by any person directly 12 associated with the mixed martial arts or boxing match, including the contestants, spectators and members of the 13 club or organization, before, after or during any match, in 14 15 or around the premises where the match is held. Nothing in 16 this subsection shall be construed to prohibit betting or 17 wagering as may be allowed by law away from the premises where the match is held, or to authorize betting or 18 19 wagering otherwise prohibited by law.

20

21 33-48-112. Examination by physician.

1 Each contestant shall be examined not more than twelve (12)

2 hours prior to a mixed martial arts or boxing match by a

3 physician who has been licensed to practice in Wyoming and

4 who has been designated by the board commission. The

5 physician shall certify in writing, over his signature, as

6 to the contestant's physical condition to engage in the

7 match. The physician's compensation shall be provided by

8 the individual promoter or entity unless otherwise agreed.

9

10 **33-48-113.** Referees.

11

12 No person shall act as a referee to a mixed martial arts <u>or</u>
13 <u>boxing</u> match without a certificate granted by the board

14 <u>commission</u>. The <u>board commission</u> is authorized to grant

15 certificates to competent referees upon the application and

16 the payment of an annual fee as established by the board

17 <u>commission</u> in accordance with W.S. 33-1-201 and the board

18 **commission** may revoke any certificate granted to any

19 referee for cause as the **board commission** may deem

20 sufficient.

21

22 33-48-114. Penalty for contestants violating rules of

23 commission.

2 (a) In addition to any penalty imposed under W.S.

3 33-48-117, any contestant who shall be found to be in

4 violation of any rule or regulation of the board commission

5 shall be penalized as follows:

6

7 (i) For the first offense he shall be restrained

8 by order of the **board commission** from participating in any

9 mixed martial arts or boxing match to be held or given by

10 any person, club, organization or corporation licensed to

11 give or hold any mixed martial arts or boxing match for a

12 period of not less than three (3) months nor more than one

13 (1) year at the discretion of the board commission;

14

15 (ii) For a second offense he shall be

16 disqualified from further admission or participation in any

17 mixed martial arts or boxing match, held or given by any

18 person, club, organization or corporation licensed under

19 this chapter.

20

21 33-48-115. Failure to make reports; unsatisfactory

22 reports; examination of records, officers.

1 Whenever any person, club, organization or corporation fails to make a report of any match at the time prescribed 2 3 by this chapter, or whenever the report is unsatisfactory 4 to the board commission, the board commission may examine or cause to be examined, the books and records of the 5 person, club, organization or corporation, and examine 6 7 under oath its officers and other persons as witnesses for 8 the purpose of determining the total amount of its gross 9 receipts for any match and the amount of monies due 10 pursuant to the provisions of this chapter. The board 11 commission shall determine the amount due based upon the 12 results of the examination. Should the person, club, 13 organization or corporation fail to pay any determined to be due, together with the expenses incurred 14 in making the examination, for a period of twenty (20) days 15 16 after notice of the amount due by the board commission, the 17 person, club, organization or corporation shall forfeit its license and shall be disqualified from receiving any new 18 license or any renewal of its license. 19 In addition, the 20 person, club, organization or corporation shall forfeit to 21 the state of Wyoming the bond required to be filed by W.S. 33-48-106, which may be recovered by the attorney general 22 in the name of the state of Wyoming. 23 Appeals of a

- 1 disqualification under this section may be made as provided
- 2 in the Wyoming Administrative Procedure Act.

4 33-48-116. Weights and classes.

5

- 6 The weights and classes of mixed martial arts and boxing
- 7 participants and the rules and regulations of mixed martial
- 8 arts and boxing shall be the same as the weights and
- 9 classes and rules and regulations adopted by the
- 10 association of boxing commissions in the unified rules of
- 11 mixed martial arts and the unified rules of boxing, except
- 12 as otherwise provided in this chapter.

13

14 **Section 2.** W.S. 33-48-101(h)(i) is repealed.

15

- 16 **Section 3.** The current members of the state board of
- 17 mixed martial arts, renamed to the Wyoming combat sports
- 18 commission in Section 1 of this act, shall continue to
- 19 serve their terms as members of the Wyoming combat sports
- 20 commission pursuant to the provisions of W.S. 33-48-101, as
- 21 amended by Section 1 of this act.

1 Section 4. The Wyoming combat sports commission,

2 renamed from the state board of mixed martial arts in

3 Section 1 of this act, shall promulgate all rules necessary

4 to conduct boxing matches in this state and otherwise to

5 implement this act.

6

7 **Section 5.** On the effective date of this act, all

8 unobligated and unencumbered funds within the mixed martial

9 arts board account shall be transferred to the Wyoming

10 combat sports commission account, as renamed in Section 1

11 of this act.

12

13 **Section 6.** This act is effective immediately upon

14 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law

15 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming

16 Constitution.
