Wage claim assignment and investigations.

## A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to labor and employment; authorizing the department of workforce services to accept assignment of 2 wage claims; authorizing the department to bring legal 3 4 action regarding assigned wage claims; authorizing the department to investigate certain activities to 5 aid enforcement of laws related to wages; and providing for an 6 7 effective date.

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9 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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11 **Section 1.** W.S. 27-4-509 is created to read:

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13 27-4-509. Assignment of wage claims.

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- Following a determination of a valid claim under W.S. 15
- 16 27-4-504(a), upon the written request of the employee the

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- 1 department may take assignment of the wage claim in trust
- 2 for the employee and may bring any legal action necessary
- 3 to collect the claim. The employer shall be required to pay
- 4 the costs and reasonable attorney's fees as may be allowed
- 5 by the court. The department shall have the power to join
- 6 claimants against the same employer in one (1) action for
- 7 purposes of this section.

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- 9 **Section 2.** W.S. 27-4-501(a)(v) and 27-4-504 by
- 10 creating a new subsection (e) are amended to read:

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12 **27-4-501.** Definitions.

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14 (a) Whenever used in this act:

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- 16 (v) "This act" means W.S. 27-4-501 through
- $17 \quad \frac{27-4-508}{27-4-509}$ .

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- 19 **27-4-504.** Investigation and determination of unpaid
- 20 wage claims; hearing; orders; collection of unpaid wages.

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- 22 (e) If an employer in this state has filed an action
- 23 <u>in bankruptcy</u>, the department may investigate and gather

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1	data regarding the wages, hours and other conditions and
2	practices of employment of the employer. For purposes of an
3	investigation under this subsection, the department may
4	enter and inspect places and records, question employees
5	and investigate any facts, conditions, practices or matters
6	that the department deems necessary or appropriate to
7	determine whether any employer or other person has violated
8	any provision of this act or to aid in the enforcement of
9	the provisions of this act. Information collected and the
10	results of an investigation under this section shall not be
11	a public record under the Wyoming Public Records Act, W.S.
12	16-4-201 through 16-4-205.
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14	Section 3. This act is effective immediately upon
15	completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
16	as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
17	Constitution.
