## A BILL

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5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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- 7 **Section 1.** W.S. 9-1-507(a)(v)(intro) and (vi) and
- 8 9-1-513(b) by creating a new paragraph (x) are amended to
- 9 read:

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- 9-1-507. Examination of books of state institutions,
- 12 agencies and certain districts and entities; independent
- 13 audit authorized; guidelines.

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- 15 (a) The director of the state department of audit
- 16 shall:

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2 (v) Perform an audit or specified procedures of 3 any books and records of any state institution, state 4 agency, incorporated city or town with a population of less than four thousand (4,000) inhabitants or any district or 5 entity described in W.S. 16-4-125(c) whenever the director 6 feels the audit or procedures are necessary. In lieu of 7 performing such audit or procedures, the director may 8 9 accept an audit or specified procedures performed by a 10 certified public accountant. The results of any audit or 11 specified procedures performed pursuant to this paragraph 12 shall be reported to the management audit committee created by W.S. 28-8-107. Specified procedures shall include 13 14 procedures conducted under one (1) of the following 15 standards:

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(vi) Conduct performance measure reviews based on the standards developed in W.S. 28-1-115(a)(ii)(A). The director shall determine the means to be used to verify and validate the performance measures. The results of the reviews shall be reported to the agency head, governor, management audit committee and secretary of state;
