1 (f) Notwithstanding W.S. 18-3-302(a)(i) or subsection 2 (c) of this section, at the request of the board of county 3 commissioners and if deemed advisable by the attorney 4 general, the attorney general may consult with or act 5 jointly with the county attorney or may act on behalf of the county in a bankruptcy proceeding where the county has 6 7 an interest in collecting taxes from the entity seeking 8 bankruptcy. The costs of the bankruptcy proceeding shall be allocated pursuant to an agreement between the state and 9 10 the county. 11 12 Section 2. This act is effective immediately upon 13 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming 14 Constitution. 15 16 17 (END)
