A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to the Wyoming department of agriculture;
2 increasing specified fees; and providing for an effective
3 date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 11-13-105(d), 11-14-104(c),
8 11-17-204(b) and 40-10-136(a)(i) through (iii) are amended
9 to read:

11 **11-13-105. Registration; fees; disposition thereof.**

12

13 (d) Each application for registration shall be
14 accompanied with a ~~twenty dollar (\$20.00)~~ forty dollar
15 (\$40.00) registration fee per mixture or formula. The

1 registration fee shall be deposited in the state general
2 fund.

4 **11-14-104. Registration of fertilizer, soil**
5 **conditioner and soil amendments; applications; fees;**
6 **disposition thereof; exceptions.**

7

8 (c) A registration fee of ~~seventy five dollars~~
9 ~~(\$75.00)~~ one hundred fifteen dollars (\$115.00) shall
10 accompany each separate formula of brand and grade of
11 fertilizer, soil conditioner or soil amendment to be
12 registered. The registration expires on December 31 next
13 following the date of application and shall be renewed
14 annually. All registration fees collected shall be
15 deposited in the state general fund and may be appropriated
16 by the legislature for programs authorized by W.S.
17 11-2-202(a)(v), 11-14-101 through 11-14-116 and
18 11-16-105(a)(v).

20 **11-17-204. Registration; fees; audit.**

1 (b) Every registrant of animal remedies shall pay a
2 registration fee of ~~twenty dollars (\$20.00)~~ thirty dollars
3 (\$30.00) per product.

4
5 **40-10-136. License required; fee.**

6
7 (a) Every person who owns or is responsible for a
8 weight, measure, weighing or measuring device regulated by
9 this act shall obtain an annual license for each
10 establishment on or before April 1 from the department and
11 pay a fee as provided in this subsection. The fees
12 collected by the department under this section shall be
13 deposited in the general fund. Fees shall be set by the
14 department as follows:

15
16 (i) Not less than ~~ten dollars (\$10.00)~~ fifteen
17 dollars (\$15.00) nor more than ~~twenty-five dollars (\$25.00)~~
18 forty dollars (\$40.00) for establishments with no more than
19 five (5) devices;

20
21 (ii) Not less than ~~twenty-five dollars (\$25.00)~~
22 forty dollars (\$40.00) nor more than ~~fifty dollars (\$50.00)~~

1 seventy-five dollars (\$75.00) for establishments with more
2 than five (5) and less than eleven (11) devices;

3

4 (iii) Not more than ~~seventy five dollars~~
5 ~~(\$75.00)~~ one hundred fifteen dollars (\$115.00) for
6 establishments with eleven (11) or more devices.

7

8 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2020.
