A BILL

for

- 1 AN ACT relating to state lands; requiring the board of land
- 2 commissioners to promulgate notice and public comment
- 3 requirements for proposed land exchanges as specified; and

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- 14 (a) The board of land commissioners is hereby
- 15 authorized and empowered to pass and promulgate all such

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1 orders, rules and regulations as may be necessary or 2 required relative to the appraisal and valuation of the 3 lands to be exchanged as provided in this act, and to 4 provide for the execution of conveyances, contracts and 5 other instruments pertaining to the exchange of the lands, and to enable the director to effect and complete each 6 exchange of the lands. The rules shall include requirements 7 8 for providing immediate public notice and posting of any proposal for land exchanges received by the office of state 9 10 lands and investments or made by the director. The rules 11 shall also provide an opportunity for public comment before 12 any exchange is completed under this section. The board may 13 authorize the purchase of lands only in an amount necessary to effect and complete the exchange of state-owned lands 14 for other lands and only for those lands identified in the 15 16 authorization of purchase. The board shall not use the 17 power of eminent domain pursuant to W.S. 1-26-801 et seq. to purchase any lands under this section. The board of land 18 19 commissioners is authorized to promulgate rules 20 regulations necessary to implement the exchange of state 21 lands on a value for value basis. The exchange program may authorize a cash equalization receipt or payment of up to 22 23 twenty-five percent (25%) of the value of the

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1 exchanged. Any receipt shall be deposited into, and any

2 payment shall be made from, the permanent land fund. State

3 lands may be exchanged upon the board's finding the

4 exchange is necessary to:
