A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to wildlife conservation; authorizing

2 acceptance and solicitation of donations for wildlife

3 conservation efforts related to the transportation system;

4 and providing for an effective date.

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6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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8 **Section 1.** W.S. 31-2-231(a) and (b) is amended to read:

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10 31-2-231. Wildlife conservation license plates;

11 wildlife conservation account; authority to receive and

12 expend monies.

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14 (a) Any person required to register a vehicle in

15 Wyoming pursuant to this article may apply to the department

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1 for a statement of eligibility for wildlife conservation 2 license plates for any motor vehicle that is not a commercial 3 vehicle or multipurpose vehicle owned or leased by that person 4 upon registration of the vehicle. The department may include 5 as part of the application the option for the applicant to 6 donate an additional amount in support of wildlife conservation. Upon payment by the applicant of a fee of one 7 8 hundred fifty dollars (\$150.00) to the department, plus any 9 additional voluntary amount, the department shall issue a 10 written statement of eligibility for wildlife conservation 11 license plates. The department shall assess an annual fee of fifty dollars (\$50.00) for a person to retain eligibility for 12 13 wildlife conservation plates, but this annual fee shall not 14 be charged in the year the person pays the one hundred fifty 15 dollars (\$150.00) eligibility fee. The person may submit an 16 additional voluntary amount in support of wildlife 17 conservation when remitting the annual fee.

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(b) The fees collected under subsection (a) of this section shall be payable to the department and shall be accounted for separately. The fees collected shall be distributed to the wildlife conservation account within the state highway fund, which is hereby created. The wildlife

conservation account shall be administered in accordance with

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2 the following: 3 4 (i) Funds in the wildlife conservation account <u>are</u> 5 continuously appropriated to the department and shall only be used to provide for wildlife conservation efforts related to 6 the transportation system, including signage, wildlife 7 8 corridors, wildlife crossings and game fences. The department, after consultation with the commission, may 9 10 expend money received and the proceeds or other property likewise received and disposed of by the department for the 11 12 purposes of this section; 13 14 (ii) The department may establish methods to accept voluntary contributions in support of wildlife 15 16 conservation efforts related to the transportation system for deposit into the wildlife conservation account. The 17 department may suggest and solicit specific contribution 18 19 amounts; 20 (iii) The department, in consultation with the 21 22 commission, shall have the authority to receive and credit to the wildlife conservation account, any money or property of 23

any kind or character, donated, granted or bequeathed to the 1

2 commission, the department or the state of Wyoming for

3 wildlife conservation efforts related to the transportation

4 system and to carry out the terms, if any, of the grant,

donation or bequest, or in the absence of any terms or 5

6 limitations, to expend the money or the proceeds of the

property as it may deem advisable for wildlife conservation 7

8 efforts related to the transportation system under the

9 provisions of this section;

the wildlife conservation account.

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(iv) The state treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to receive and credit to the wildlife conservation account any grant, donation or bequest that is made to the commission, the department or the state of Wyoming for wildlife conservation efforts related to the transportation system that contains a condition or restriction that the income only therefrom shall be expended for the purposes provided by this section. The state treasurer shall invest any money received under this paragraph in accordance with law and the interest received thereon shall be deposited into
