1 (b) Before a secured party may take control of a

2 digital asset under this section, the secured party shall

3 enter into a control agreement with the debtor. A control

4 agreement may also set forth the terms under which a

5 secured party may pledge its security interest in the

6 digital asset as collateral for another transaction.

8 34-29-104. Digital asset custodial services.

10 (n) Banks are not subject to the annual report 11 license tax levied under W.S. 17-16-1630. In lieu of this 12 tax and To offset the costs of supervision administration of this section, a bank which provides 13 custodial services under this section shall 14 supervision fee equal to two-tenths of one mill on the 15 16 dollar (\$.0002) relating to assets held in custody under 17 this section as of December 31 of each year, with payment of the supervision fee made on or before the following 18 January 31. The supervision fee shall be deposited by the 19 20 commissioner into the financial institutions administration 21 account and may be expended for any purpose authorized for that account. Banks providing custodial services outside of 22

this section shall not be required to pay this supervision
fee.

6 <u>Subject to other jurisdictional limits placed on specific</u>

7 courts by Wyoming law, the courts of Wyoming shall have

8 jurisdiction to hear claims in both law and equity relating

9 to digital assets, including those arising from this

10 chapter and the Uniform Commercial Code, title 34.1,

11 Wyoming statutes.

13 **Section 2.** This act is effective immediately upon

14 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law

15 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming

16 Constitution.
