AN ACT relating to the prioritization of municipal solid 1 2 waste facilities cease and transfer projects; authorizing expenditure of previously appropriated funds; establishing 3 a prioritized list of projects; establishing a maximum 4 5 amount to be expended on projects; granting the department б of environmental quality limited discretionary authority to modify the prioritized list; specifying expenditures for a 7 8 carcass management project; providing definitions; repealing a prior list of priority cease and transfer 9 10 projects; requiring reports; and providing for an effective 11 date.
