LEVEL I RECONNAISSANCE STUDIES - NEW 14 DEVELOPMENT. The following sums of money are appropriated 15 16 from water development account I, as created by W.S. 1 SF0061

1 41-2-124(a)(i), to the water development commission to be 2 expended to conduct the following reconnaissance studies as 3 defined in W.S. 41-2-114. Funds appropriated under this 4 section for a particular project which are in excess of the actual amount necessary to complete the study may, subject 5 to the review of the select water committee, be expended by 6 7 the commission to complete the reconnaissance study for any 8 other project listed in this section. Appropriated funds not obligated prior to July 1, 2023 shall revert to water 9 10 development account I. The commission shall submit a report to the legislature on each of the following studies prior 11 12 to the 2022 legislative session:

Section 5. There is appropriated one hundred seventyfive thousand dollars (\$175,000.00) to the Wyoming water development commission from water development account I, as

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1 created by W.S. 41-2-124(a)(i), to fund the office of water 2 programs established under W.S. 41-2-125 for the period 3 beginning July 1, 2020 and ending June 30, 2022. This 4 appropriation shall not be transferred or expended for any 5 other purpose and any unexpended, unobligated funds 6 remaining from this appropriation shall revert as provided 7 by law on June 30, 2022.

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9 Section 6. This act is effective immediately upon 10 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law 11 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming 12 Constitution.
