A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to worker's compensation; providing a
2 premium credit for employers as specified; and providing
3 for an effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.** Pursuant to W.S. 27-14-201(q), the
8 department of workforce services shall establish a premium
9 credit for any employer who has made all required worker's
10 compensation payments for the period beginning January 1,
11 2019 and ending December 31, 2019. To qualify for the
12 credit, an employer shall be in good standing with the
13 worker's compensation division within the department of
14 workforce services for all required worker's compensation
15 payments by June 15, 2020. Premium credits granted under

1 this act shall become effective on August 1, 2020 and may
2 be used for premium reporting periods from July 1, 2020
3 through December 31, 2020. Any unused credit will expire
4 January 31, 2021.

5

6 **Section 2.** This act is effective immediately upon
7 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
8 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
9 Constitution.
