7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

- 9 **Section 1.** W.S. 26-4-102(b)(ii), 35-9-621(e) and
- 10 35-9-628(a)(intro) are amended to read:

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- 12 **26-4-102.** Record of receipts; payment to treasurer;
- 13 credit to fund.

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- 15 (b) The commissioner shall promptly deposit all
- 16 monies he receives from any charges to the general fund,

1 with receipt and acknowledgement submitted to the state

2 treasurer, except that:

4 (ii) An amount not to exceed eighty percent

5 (80%) Up to one hundred percent (100%) of the gross premium

6 tax levied upon fire insurance premiums shall be deposited

7 by the state treasurer in the volunteer firefighter, EMT

8 and search and rescue pension account pursuant to W.S.

9 35-9-628. For purposes of this paragraph, the gross premium

18 (e) A volunteer firefighter or volunteer EMT is a

19 participating member under this article for each month a

20 contribution of fifteen dollars (\$15.00) eighteen dollars

21 and seventy-five cents (\$18.75) is made by or on behalf of

22 the member. A volunteer search and rescue person is a

23 participating member under this article for each month a

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1 contribution of thirty dollars (\$30.00) thirty-seven 2 dollars and fifty cents (\$37.50) is made by or on behalf of 3 the member. For purposes of eligibility for benefits under 4 subsections (b) and (c) of this section, a volunteer search 5 firefighter, EMTand or rescue person is participating member beginning the first month following 6 7 the month in which the required monthly payment and any 8 required application for participation is actually received 9 Wyoming retirement system. To continue as by the 10 participating member, subsequent monthly payments shall be 11 received by the Wyoming retirement system not later than 12 three (3) months following the close of the calendar month 13 for which the payments are applicable. With the consent of and upon any terms and conditions established by the board, 14 payments may be accepted at an earlier or later date. The 15 16 board shall maintain full and complete records of 17 contributions made on behalf of each participating member and on request, shall furnish any participating member a 18 19 statement of the contribution amounts and the dates for 20 which contributions were received. If contributions have 21 varied in amount, the board may make appropriate awarded. 22 adjustments in the benefits In making 23 adjustment, the board shall be guided by actuarial practice

15 under W.S. 26-4-102(b)(ii) and provided by W.S.

16 26-4-103(k). The sum specified shall be calculated by the
