- 14 The commonly accepted means of care that would be rendered
- 15 to any other infant born alive shall be employed in the

1 treatment of any viable infant aborted alive. with any

2 chance of survival. Any physician performing an abortion

3 shall take all medically appropriate and reasonable steps

4 to preserve the life and health of an infant born alive.

5 The parents of an infant born alive shall not be held

6 <u>criminally or civilly liable for the actions of a physician</u>

7 <u>under this section</u>.

9 Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2020.
