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14 (m) In determining the amount to be included in the 15 foundation program for each district, the state 16 superintendent shall:

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2 (v) Based upon ADM computations and identified 3 school configurations within each district pursuant to 4 paragraph (iv) of this subsection, compute the foundation program amount for each district as prescribed by the 5 education resource block grant model adopted by the Wyoming б legislature as defined under W.S. 21-13-101(a)(xiv), as 7 contained within the spreadsheets and accompanying reports 8 referenced under W.S. 21-13-101(a)(xvii).
