to coercion and was not providing forced services when engaging in the act;

(ii) Shall be rebuttably presumed to be a victim of human trafficking in any criminal charge as a result of engaging in the commercial sex act, regardless of whether any other person is identified or prosecuted as a result of engaging in the commercial sex act. The presumption shall be overcome only by establishing beyond a reasonable doubt that the minor was not subject to coercion and was not providing forced services when engaging in the commercial sex act."
