"(c) If an event calls for closure of a state highway within an incorporated city or town, ~~for which there is no readily accessible alternate route,~~ the city or town shall ~~request department approval for the closure~~ submit to the department an application for highway closure with a map or drawing depicting the proposed highway detour, including signage. If the department determines the proposed detour is inadequate to accommodate the highway traffic, the department shall work with the city or town to identify a suitable detour.
