"(B) Upon application of the student, the commission may relieve a student of the obligation to repay amounts expended under subparagraph (A) of this paragraph, in whole or in part, where repayment would cause undue hardship. If, within three (3) years following conclusion of professional training, a student is not able after diligent efforts to attain a professional position in Wyoming in the field in which the student was educated and for which annual monetary compensation equals or exceeds one-half (1/2) of the national average educational debt for that profession, then all unpaid repayment obligations incurred under this article shall be waived. The commission shall annually report the number of students relieved from repayment under this subparagraph to the joint labor, health and social services interim committee not later than October 1;".
