## A BILL

for

- 1 AN ACT relating to motor vehicles; prohibiting enforcement
- 2 of traffic violations using an automated traffic
- 3 enforcement system; prohibiting use of information obtained
- 4 through an automated traffic enforcement system; and
- 5 providing for an effective date.

7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

9 **Section 1.** W.S. 31-1-204 is created to read:

11 31-1-204. Automated traffic enforcement systems.

- 13 (a) Neither the state of Wyoming nor any agency,
- 14 instrumentality or political subdivision thereof shall
- 15 employ or contract with any private entity to employ an

1 automated traffic enforcement system, except as authorized

2 under W.S. 21-3-131(b)(x) and 31-5-507(e) for school bus

3 video systems. Nothing in this subsection prevents a law

4 enforcement officer from using a photographic or other

5 enforcement assistance device for the purpose of personally

6 detecting a violation of a state traffic law under title 31

7 of the Wyoming statutes where a citation is delivered to

8 the driver of a vehicle at the time and place of an alleged

9 offense.

11 (b) Neither the state of Wyoming nor any agency,

12 instrumentality or political subdivision thereof shall

13 provide or contract to provide to another state or any

14 agency, instrumentality or political subdivision thereof

15 any information used to impose or collect a civil or

16 criminal fine that results from an alleged violation of a

17 state traffic law under title 31 of the Wyoming statutes

18 captured by an automated traffic enforcement system in this

19 state.

21 **Section 2.** W.S. 31-1-101(a) by creating a new

22 paragraph (xxxv) is amended to read:

1 **31-1-101.** Definitions.

3 (a) Except as otherwise provided, as used in this
4 act:

6 (xxxv) "Automated traffic enforcement system"

7 means a red light camera, a speed camera or any other

8 device used to detect a violation of a state traffic law

9 under title 31 of the Wyoming statutes without requiring a

10 law enforcement officer to be present to witness the

violation, which results in a notice of the violation being

delivered to the registered owner of a vehicle.

14 Section 3. Neither the state of Wyoming nor any agency, instrumentality or political subdivision thereof 15 16 shall provide information used to impose or collect a civil 17 or criminal fine that results from a violation captured by an automated traffic enforcement system as defined in 18 19 W.S. 31-1-101(a)(xxxv) pursuant to any existing interstate 20 compact or contract entered into before July 1, 2021 if 21 that compact or contract does not specifically allow, or require, information to be shared for 22 that 23 purpose. The state of Wyoming or any agency,

- 2 renew any existing compact or contract provision or enter
- 3 into any new compact or contract provision that requires
- 4 provision of information used to impose or collect a civil
- 5 or criminal fine that results from a violation captured by

- $7 \quad 31-1-101(a)(xxxv)$ .

9 Section 4. This act is effective July 1, 2021.
