## A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to commercial vehicles; increasing fees for

2 oversize and overweight vehicles; and providing for an

3 effective date.

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5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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- 7 **Section 1.** W.S. 31-18-201(s) and 31-18-804(a), (b),
- 8 (d), (f) and (g) are amended to read:

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- 10 31-18-201. Commercial vehicles; registration;
- 11 exemptions.

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- 13 (s) Except as otherwise provided in this section,
- 14 owners of commercial vehicles meeting the registration
- 15 requirements of another jurisdiction and subject to
- 16 registration in Wyoming and not entitled to exemption from

1 registration or licensing under this section may, as an 2 alternative to registration or proportional registration 3 secure a temporary permit from the department to make a 4 single trip into, within or out of Wyoming for a period of not to exceed ninety-six (96) hours for a fee of twenty 5 dollars (\$20.00) fifty dollars (\$50.00) for each single 6 7 unit operated as a single unit or forty dollars (\$40.00) 8 one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for each legal combination of units including only one (1) power unit. In lieu of the fee 9 10 required by W.S. 39-17-106(q) or 39-17-206(d) for license 11 and taxation of gasoline or diesel fuels the operator may 12 secure a temporary permit from the department to operate in Wyoming for a period of not to exceed ninety-six (96) hours 13 for a fee of seven dollars and fifty cents (\$7.50) twenty 14 15 dollars (\$20.00) for each single unit operated as a single 16 unit or fifteen dollars (\$15.00) thirty-five dollars 17 (\$35.00) for each legal combination of units including only one (1) power unit. 18

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20 31-18-804. Permits for and certain highways to carry,
21 overweight and oversize vehicles; government vehicles.

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1 (a) The director or his authorized representative may 2 issue permits for separate movements or extended periods of 3 movement effective for one (1) or more months, not to 4 exceed ninety (90) days permitting hauling of forest 5 products, baled hay or combine headers. No permit issued under this section shall be granted for any load of forest 6 products exceeding one hundred twelve (112) inches in width 7 8 or any load of baled hay or combine headers exceeding one 9 hundred fifty (150) inches in width and fifteen (15) feet 10 in height. No single component of the load may exceed one hundred two (102) inches in width. The fee for a single 11 12 trip permit is fifteen dollars (\$15.00) thirty-five dollars 13 (\$35.00). The fee for an extended period permit is fifty dollars (\$50.00) one hundred six dollars (\$106.00). 14

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16 (b) The director or his authorized representative may 17 issue a permit exclusive of interstate highways for hauling of forest products, sugar beets, gravel, livestock and 19 agricultural products hauled in trucks that cannot be 20 weighed at point of loading at a weight which is not more 21 than ten percent (10%) in excess of allowable axle weights and not more than five thousand (5,000) pounds in excess of 22 gross weights allowed under gross weight Table I. 23

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permit fee is fifteen dollars (\$15.00) thirty-five dollars 1 2 (\$35.00) for a single trip permit not to exceed ninety-six 3 (96) continuous hours. The permit fee is fifty dollars 4 (\$50.00) one hundred six dollars (\$106.00) for any ninety (90) continuous days. If a truck hauling forest products, 5 sugar beets, gravel, livestock or agricultural products 6 exceeds the legal weight limitations, the truck shall be 7 8 allowed to unload at its point of destination in this state if the point of destination is within one (1) mile of the 9 10 truck's location when the illegal weight limitation was 11 determined, unless an immediate threat to public safety 12 exists. No penalty for the first violation shall be 13 imposed, but any subsequent violation shall be subject to the penalty provisions of W.S. 31-18-805. 14

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16 (d) For movements of a vehicle without load, 17 indivisible load requirements, or a meeting trailer carrying a recreational boat that exceeds any 18 maximum 19 dimension or weight authorized under W.S. 31-18-802, the 20 director or his authorized representative may upon 21 application issue a permit in writing effective for an extended period of time, not to exceed one (1) year, 22 authorizing the movement of the vehicle, provided that the 23

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size does not exceed seventy-five (75) feet in length for a 1 2 single vehicle and twelve (12) feet in width or fifteen 3 (15) feet in height for a single vehicle or combination of 4 vehicles. The permit fee for an oversize vehicle is fifty 5 dollars (\$50.00) one hundred six dollars (\$106.00). The 6 director or his authorized representative may upon application issue a permit effective for one (1) year, 7 8 authorizing the commercial movement of one (1) or more 9 motor homes, house trailers or truck campers that exceed 10 the maximum width authorized under W.S. 31-18-802(a)(i)(A). 11 A copy of the permit shall be carried with the vehicle. 12 The fee for such a permit shall not exceed two hundred 13 fifty dollars (\$250.00) five hundred dollars (\$500.00). 14 Notwithstanding subsections (e) through (t) of 15 section, no additional permit requirements shall be imposed 16 upon the commercial movement of such vehicles if such 17 vehicles comply with W.S. 31-18-802(a)(i)(A). The permit 18 fee for overweight vehicle is as prescribed an in 19 subsection (g) of this section. Extended period permits are 20 not authorized for transportable homes as defined in W.S. 21 31-1-101.

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1 (f) When an oversize single trip permit is issued,

2 the fee is <del>twenty five dollars (\$25.00)</del> <u>fifty dollars</u>

3 (\$50.00). Should any vehicle including load exceed the

4 dimensions of fifteen (15) feet in width or fifteen (15)

5 feet in height or any single vehicle including load exceed

6 seventy-five (75) feet in length, an additional fee shall

7 be paid in excess of the above limitation computed at the

8 rate of three cents (\$.03) six cents (\$.06) for each foot

9 or fraction thereof for each mile traveled on the highways.

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11 (q) When an overweight permit is issued, the fee is 12 six cents (\$.06) twelve cents (\$.12) for each ton or 13 fraction thereof of weight in excess of the weight limitation under W.S. 31-18-802 for each mile traveled on 14 the highways. In no event shall the fee be less than forty 15 16 dollars (\$40.00) eighty dollars (\$80.00) for the permit. A 17 permit under this section for loads exceeding eighty (80) tons shall not be issued until the permittee has paid all 18 19 incurred by the state determine to 20 structure, highway capability to withstand the load and the 21 incurred by sending personnel to accompany the

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movement of the load.
