- 8 **Section 1.** W.S. 27-9-105(a) by creating a new
- 9 paragraph (v) is amended to read:

- 11 27-9-105. Discriminatory and unfair employment
- 12 practices enumerated; limitations.

- 14 (a) It is a discriminatory or unfair employment
- 15 practice:

2	(v) For an employer to terminate the employment
3	of any employee because of the employee's engagement or
4	participation in any lawful activity during nonworking
5	hours that occurs off of the employer's premises or for an
6	employer to restrict an employee's ability to participate
7	in any lawful activity during nonworking hours that occurs
8	off of the employer's premises unless the restriction:
9	
10	(A) Relates to a bona fide occupational
11	requirement or is reasonably and rationally related to the
12	employment activities and responsibilities of a particular
13	employee or particular group of employees rather than all
14	employees of the employer; or
15	
16	(B) Is necessary to avoid a conflict of
17	interest or the appearance of a conflict of interest with
18	any responsibilities to the employer.

20	Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2021.
