28-8-104. Direction by legislature during sessions;
2 joint interim committees; requests for services;

3 establishment of priorities; appointment of select

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7 (b) When the legislature is not in regular or special session, the respective standing committees of the house 8 9 and senate shall function as joint interim committees. Each 10 of these interim committees shall select a prioritized list of interim topics to consider during the interim. 11 12 Management Council may assign additional topics to a joint 13 interim committee for study. Joint interim committees may request the office to perform specific studies and services 14 that will incur additional costs for the interim committee 15 16 conditioned only upon receipt of prior approval of the 17 committee's request by the management council. priorities based upon limitation of time and appropriation 18 19 of the office shall be established by the management 20 council and followed by the interim committees and 21 individual legislators. Management council shall only limit the number and scope of interim topics to be studied by an 22 interim committee based on the availability of funding and 23

1 staffing as determined by the management council. Removal 2 of any topic under these constraints shall start with those 3 topics assigned the lowest priority by the interim 4 committee and move sequentially to the next lowest 5 priority. Any specific study or service that is approved by the management council, including bill drafting 6 7 prefiling, shall be done under the supervision of the 8 appropriate interim committee or the individual legislator. Any joint interim committee may request management council 9 10 approval for additional meeting days or an increase in the 11 committee's budget, which management council shall not 12 unreasonably deny. In addition to other authority granted and limitations imposed by this subsection, management 13 14 council may: 15 16 (i) Assign additional topics to a joint interim 17 committee; 18 19 (ii) Reassign topics selected by a joint interim 20 committee to another joint interim committee or a select 21 committee pursuant to subsection (c) of this section; 22

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4	(c) The management council shall have the right, when
5	a joint interim committee is not performing its assigned an
6	approved study or when a special study is desired, to
7	appoint create or designate a select committee of not less

11	to any select committee created by management council under

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14	(i) The president of the senate and the speaker

5	special or select committee to study a topic in the interim
6	that deals with the same or a materially same subject as
7	any bill that failed to pass either chamber in the

11	select committee that addresses a subject that is within
12	the purview of a materially similar subject studied by a
13	joint interim committee, the bill shall be referred to the
14	standing committee for sponsorship, notwithstanding any
15	provisions to the contrary.

17	(d) <u>Upon request by a joint interim committee, the</u>
18	management council shall have the right to may fill any
19	vacancy or enlarge any committee to facilitate the
20	consideration of any interim topics or assigned approved
21	studies conducted during the interim.

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1 Section 2. The management council shall update and

2 revise any necessary policies and procedures to fulfill the

3 requirements of this act.

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5 **Section 3.** This act is effective immediately upon

6 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law

7 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming

8 Constitution.
