Page 2-line 2 After "<u>exemption</u>." insert "<u>This paragraph is repealed</u> December 31, 2025.".

Page 5-after line 3 Insert:

"Section 2. The exemption provided by this act shall first apply to the tax year beginning January 1, 2024.

Section 3. There is appropriated forty million dollars (\$40,000,000.00) from the general fund to the department of revenue to provide reimbursement to the school foundation program and to local governments for the reduction in revenue caused by the homeowner's exemption implemented under this act. This appropriation shall be for the period beginning with the effective date of this act and ending June 30, 2026. This appropriation shall not be transferred or expended for any other purpose and any unexpended, unobligated funds remaining from this appropriation shall revert as provided by law on June 30, 2026. It is the intent of the legislature that this appropriation not be included in the standard budget for the department of revenue for the immediately succeeding fiscal biennium.".
