- Page 2-line 7 After "invest" insert "not less than fifty percent (50%) of the unobligated, unencumbered balance of the funds within the account in short term fixed income investment grade securities and may invest up to fifty percent (50%) of the unobligated, unencumbered balance of the". HB0208S2002/ADOPTED

Delete the Gierau, et al. second reading amendment (HB0208S2001/AE) entirely and further amend as follows:

- Page 1-line 3 Delete "equities" and insert "fixed income securities".
- Page 1-line 4 After "account;" insert "providing for the transfer of funds;".
- Page 2-line 7 Delete "equities, including".
- Page 2-line 8 Delete "stocks of corporations" and insert "fixed income investment-grade securities".
- Page 2-after line 15 Insert and renumber as necessary:

"Section 2.

(a) Not later than January 2, 2024, the state auditor shall transfer one hundred forty million dollars (\$140,000,000.00), or as much thereof as is available, from the common school permanent fund reserve account to the school foundation program reserve account.

(b) Not later than January 3, 2024, the state auditor shall transfer two hundred million dollars (\$200,000,000.00), or as much thereof as is available, from the school foundation program reserve account to the common school account within the permanent land fund.

(c) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the transfers required in this section shall be completed before the transfer required in 2023 House Bill 0001, Section 300(hh), as enacted into law.".
